



Each person has some traits that separate him or her from all other people. God is like that, too. He has many special qualities that separate Him from every other being in the Universe. - · God is omnipresent (OM-NEE-PREZ-ENT), or all present, meaning that He is everywhere at the same time (Psalm 139:7-10).
- God is omnibenevolent (OM-NEE-BE-NEV-UH-LENT), or all loving (1 John 4:8.16).
- God is just and righteous (Psalm 99:4).
- God is merciful (Exodus 34:6).





Creation Maze




