GUIDELINES FOR \$1000 to \$2500 SCHOLARSHIP for HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR

1. Scholarship applicants must be residents of the Triangle Area.
2. The applicant must have received a high school diploma by June 2008.
3. A grade point average of 2.5 must be held by the applicant.
4. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
5. The scholarship must be used to attend any post-secondary educational or technical institution in North Carolina.
6. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the recipient's chosen college/university and is to be used for tuition or educational expenses.
7. Should the recipient withdraw before completion of the year's work, any refunds which might be payable will be returned to ASSISTANCE LEAGUE® of the Triangle Area.
8. The Scholarship Committee may personally interview all applicants before the scholarship award decisions are made.
9. The application must be submitted by **March 15, 2008** to your Guidance Counselor, for forwarding to the address below.
