GUIDELINES FOR \$1000 to \$2500 SCHOLARSHIP for SINGLE WORKING MOTHER

A scholarship will be awarded to an individual who is a single, working mother who will be or is currently attending a post-secondary educational, technical two-year or four-year institution of higher education to pursue a certificate, diploma or degree.

1. Scholarship applicants must be actively working single mothers residing in the Triangle Area and be US citizens or have permanent resident status.
2. The applicant must have a high school diploma or GED by June 2008.
3. The scholarship must be used to attend any post-secondary educational, technical two-year or four-year institution of higher education in North Carolina.
4. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
5. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the recipient's chosen college/university and is to be used for tuition or educational expenses.
6. Should the recipient withdraw before completion of the year's work, any refunds which might be payable will be returned to ASSISTANCE LEAGUE[®] of the Triangle Area.
7. Applicants may be personally interviewed by the Scholarship Committee before the scholarship is awarded.
