**Classes:** Orienteering, Fire Building, Wood Tools, Lashing

**Tour Permits:** Tour Permits **MUST** be filed with the Scout  
Office, 10 working days before the outing if you are faxing or  
mailing. You may hand deliver the permit up to the day before the  
outing. **Please do not forget about this!**

**Meals:** Each troop is responsible for their own Dinner & Breakfast. The Stakes will be providing Lunch. Don't forget you have the opportunity to have your breakfast judged.

**Items to Bring: (Leaders)** Food & Water (1 gallon for each boy to drink), all campsite materials, Patrol flag, **Wood**, Cooking Supplies, Cheer (prepared in advance), Sign for campsite to label WARD and TROOP #, Scout Spirit.

**Items to Bring: (Boys)** Compass, Flashlight, Hat, Sunscreen, Tent, Sleeping bag, WARM clothes for evening, assignment from Scout Leader.

**Guidelines for Camp Inspection:** Duty Roster, Clean, All Helping, Patrol Leader in Charge, Proper Fire, Fire Buckets in Place, Campcraft Gadgets, Hospitality, Scout Spirit

**Songs:** Armies of Helaman & On My Honor (words to scout oath) Please teach and practice these with your boys.

**Misc.**

There will be no skits this year just be ready with your troop cheer at all times.

The evening campfire is mandatory for boys and leaders.

Remember two deep leadership is a must, involve all dads and leaders.

Leaders need to rotate classes with their boys.

Scout Spirit involves wearing uniforms, troop cheer, carrying flag, showing support of one another during competitions.
