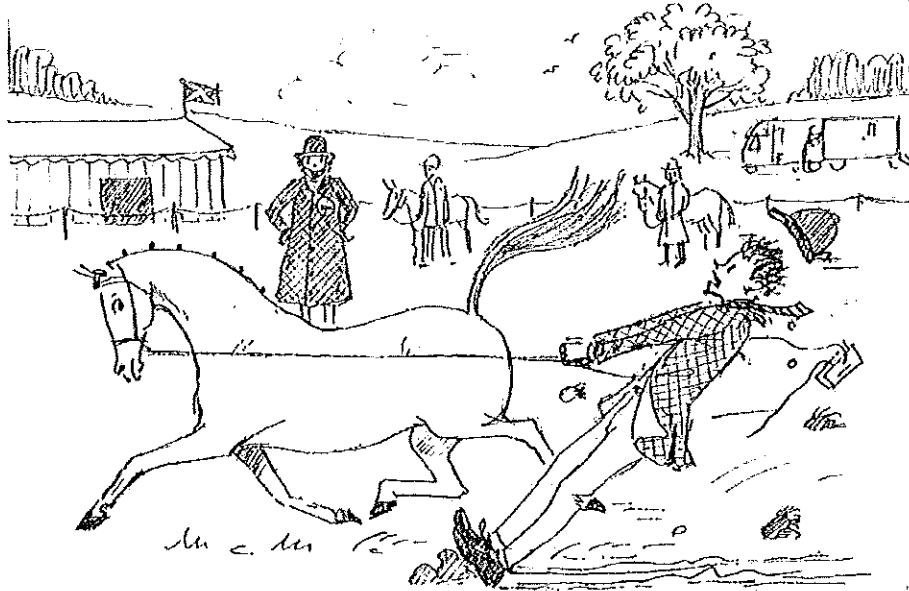

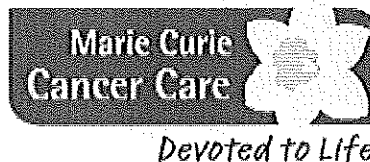

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The organisers and Land Owners shall not be liable for any claim in respect of any loss, theft, damage, illness or injury to any person, whether competitor, servant, owner or spectator, property, animal or vehicle howsoever caused in connection with or rising out of the show. It is considered a condition of entry, that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any accident, theft or loss.

First Aid cover is provided by qualified first aider and, if required, a call to the emergency services. All incidents are to be reported to the show secretary. By attending the show it is deemed that you are satisfied with this level of medical cover.

All classes will be judged according to the rules and regulations for the appropriate Society

The organisers reserve the right to alter the times of classes and the Judge if necessary

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, or expel from the showground, any person or animal without stating the reason for doing so.

*******NO refund of entry fees will be made under any circumstances. THIS INCLUDES CLASS CLASHES*******

Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30mins of the incident, accompanied by a £20 deposit, which will be returned only if the objection is held.

JUDGES DECISION IS ALWAYS FINAL

All ages are taken as from the 1st January of the current year

All colts and Stallions, two years and over must be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, NPS or appropriate Breed Society License UNLESS otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.

HANDLERS OF STALLIONS, COLT FOALS MUST HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 14TH BIRTHDAY BEFORE 1ST JANUARY OF THE CURRENT YEAR.

All Colts, Stallions, two years and over must be adequately bitted and under control.

Any exhibit deemed by the Judge or Organisers not to be under control will be asked to leave the ring.

Any foal present on the Showground must be 30 days old or over on the day of the show.

No unauthorised persons are allowed in the ring.

Breed Society members only will qualify for the Breed Society Rosettes. Cards must be produced in ring.

Excessive use of whip or spur or verbal abuse of any official, competitor, or members of the public in any class will result in disqualification and entry fees will not be returned.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, owners are responsible for cleaning up any mess made by their dogs

An exhibitor must not knowingly exhibit an equine which has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his/ her employer.

It is recommended that every animal at the show has third party insurance

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern August 2012

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. 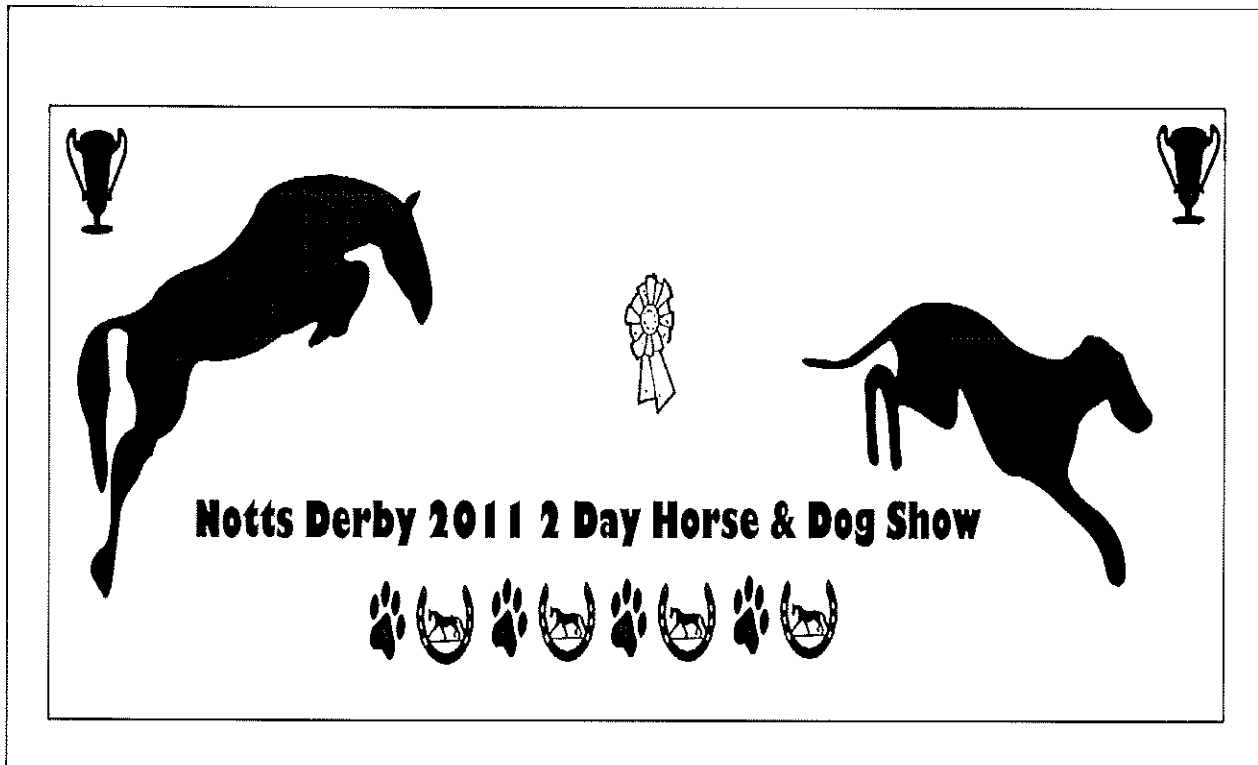
