Application fee of U.S. \$50.00 is payable with the application.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE—I submit U.S. \$50.00 as an application fee to hold a place in the class, which is applied to the total. The balance of the tuition, \$750.00 (or \$600.00, or \$300.00), is payable in advance or is payable on the first day of class. Payments may be made by: cash, check (U.S.bank), or traveler' checks (in U.S. dollars). **CREDIT CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**

TOTAL INSTRUCTIONAL COSTS: \$800.00 (3 weeks), or \$650.00 (2 weeks), or \$350.00 (1 week).

REFUND POLICY—If the prospective student cannot attend the scheduled class, the application fee will be refunded or held for a later enrollment, provided the school is notified at least 1 week (7 days) before the class begins. Otherwise, the application fee will be forfeited. If the student discontinues the scheduled class, after the class begins, the tuition will be refunded on a daily pro-rated basis. Refunds will be made within fifteen (15) calendar days from date of receipt of the cancellation/ withdrawal. All monies paid by the student will be refunded if the student is not accepted by the school or if the class is cancelled.

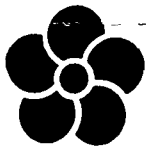
