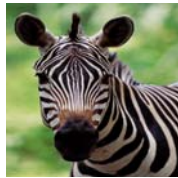

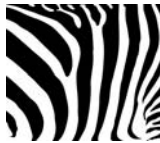

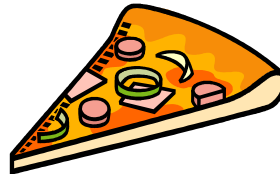

### Bonus Question Rubric

#### **Sentence**

5 = A complete sentence including conventions (capital letter, subject verb agreement and punctuation).

4 = An incomplete sentence with <2 convention errors.

3 = An incomplete sentence with >2 convention errors.

2 = Words indicating the animal, diet and habitat.

1 = Words indicating 1 or 2 of the needed parts (animal, diet, habitat).

0 = No attempt

#### **Picture**

5 = A picture including all elements (animal, diet, habitat).

3 = A picture with 2 or fewer elements

1 = Any attempt at drawing a picture

0 = No attempt
