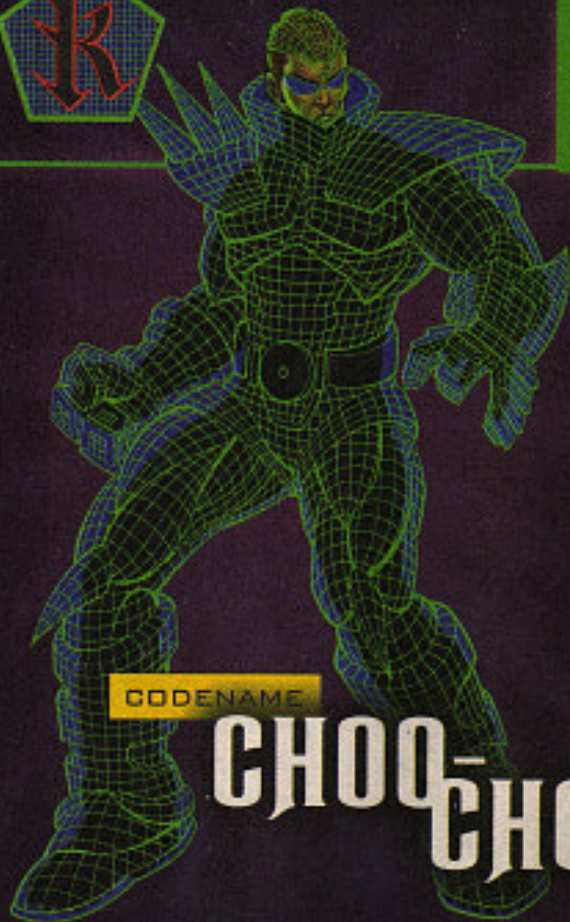
Science is her sorcery. With the harnessed power of five black holes, she empowers five knights and equips them with super energy-armor. Arthur had his round table. She has her pentable.

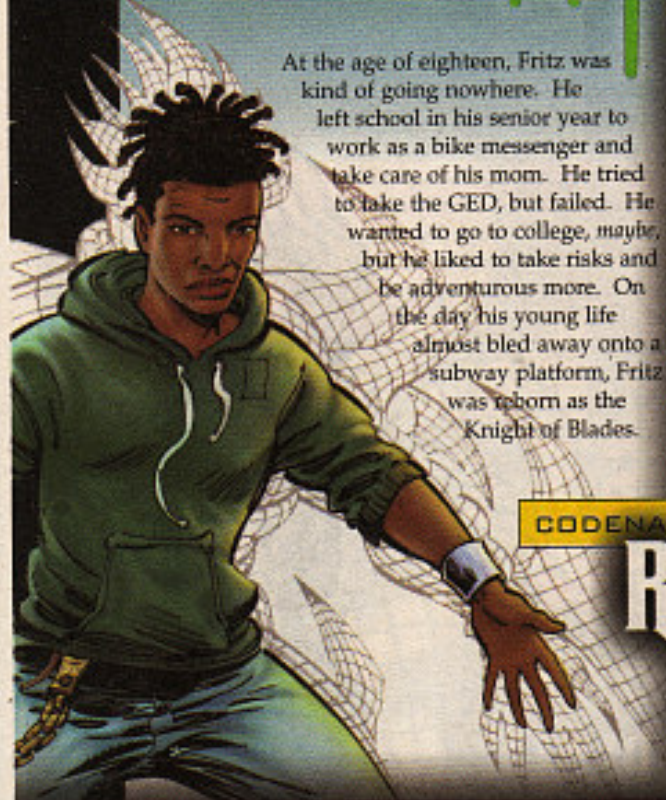

MARIE

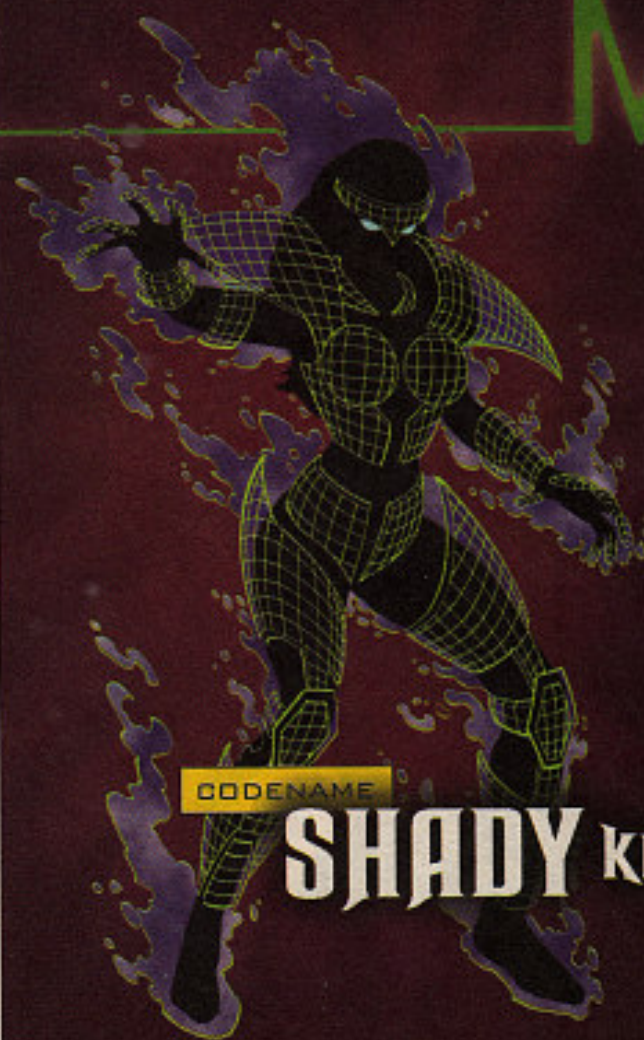
