

Directions to CHEPSTOW BEACH COTTAGE, Chepstow (Souris), P.E.I.
263 Anselm MacDonald Road, Souris, PEI C0A 2B0
If you get lost, call us at 902-687-2548 (Point Cottage), overlooking Beach Cottage

From Confederation Bridge at Borden-Carleton, P.E.I.:

- 1) Follow **Route 1** to Charlottetown (c.56 km). After crossing the North River Causeway, keep left on the highway until the lights at Upton Road.
- 2) Turn left onto Upton Road; follow it c. ½ km. to Bypass. Take right-hand exit onto Bypass Highway and follow it until the turn for Souris, at the junction with Highway 1. Get into left lane beforehand.
- 3) Turn left at **St. Peter's Road (which is also Route 2 to Souris)**. A KFC faces you at the turn.
- 4) Follow **Route 2** to Souris (81 km). (You will go through Morell, then St. Peter's, where the road goes left at the head of the Bay, and then almost immediately right at a cluster of motels and restaurants). After you've crossed the short causeway from Souris West into Souris, Route 2 becomes **Route 16 (Main Street)**; continue straight through town;
- 5) On the eastern outskirts of Souris, find the **Eastern King's Sportsplex** on your left (the Strait and the harbour are on your right);
- 6) Continue to follow Route 16 for **1.8 km** past the Sportsplex, where you'll see a sign on your right reading "**Anselm MacDonald Road**"; **turn right on it** and follow it past an old barn and the big yellow farmhouse on your left;
- 7) Anselm Macd. Road will become unpaved; at its junction with Detwiller Drive, follow its curve left along the bank by the Strait to the last cottage facing the Strait. There's a silver milk can marked "Rollins" in front and the address **263** on the cottage. Parking is on the grass on the right (east) side of the cottage. 2 vehicles should park one behind the other.

From ferry at Wood Islands:

- 1) Follow **Route 315** to Montague (25 km), then take **Route 4** to junction with **Route 2**. Turn right and proceed to Souris. Then follow #5-7 above.

When you arrive, you will find one cottage door open and the keys on the dining table.

In the cottage, please use your own calling card (or Yak: dial 10-10-925 + 1 + area code +number) when making long distance calls. Beach Cottage phone number will be written on the phone set.
