

Additional Characters

You will need the following characters to write Ecclesiastical Latin. To produce them hold down the Alt key (often located next to the space bar) while typing in the four digit code with the number pad. Make sure that the keypad is number locked (if not hit Num Lock). The number pad is on the right hand side of the keyboard on desktops. On laptops there is usually some sort of function key that turns the main keyboard into a number pad. When in doubt, ask a Computer Scientist.

Ligatures:

Character	Symbol	Keystroke
Capital A+E ligature	Æ	Alt+0198
Miniscule a+e ligature	æ	Alt+0230
Capital O+E ligature	Œ	Alt+0140
Miniscule o+e ligature	œ	Alt+0156

The a+e ligatures are available in Unicode with acute accents, but they must be inserted directly. There is no Alt keystroke for these characters. O+e ligatures require special fonts.

Capitals with Acute Accent (Primary Stress):

A with acute accent	Á	Alt+0193

Miniscules with Acute Accent (Primary Stress):

a with acute accent	á	Alt+0225

u with acute accent	ú	Alt+0250
y with acute accent	ý	Alt+0253

Y is only available with an acute accent or dieresis.
