

## **OBITUARY**

Archie Lawrence Herring was born on August 28, 1936 in Weed, Siskiyou County, California. He was the second of three children of Robert Guss & Lessie Hilliard Herring, Sr.

Archie attended Weed Elementary School with his brother and many cousins. In 1943 his family relocated to Seattle Washington where he attended F. A. McDonald Elementary School, Hamilton Junior High School and graduated from Lincoln High School in 1955. Archie went on to obtain a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from the University of Washington, graduating in 1959. While attending the university, Archie held positions as Riveter and Production Controller with the Boeing Aerospace Company to help pay school expenses.

Following graduation, Archie joined the Washington Army National Guard where he graduated from the Washington Military Academy having received the Erickson Trophy for Distinguished Graduate and also the Reserve Trophy Leadership Honor. He was honorably discharged on October 10, 1969 from the Washington Army National Guard Reserves with a rank of Captain, Medical Service Corp.

Archie joined the Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company in 1964 where he held several management positions and received several accommodations. He retired from this career in March 1986.

Archie married Constance Delores Nellams on August 10, 1968. No children were born to this union.

In 1979, Archie purchased a home in the Capitol Hill neighborhood located in the heart of Seattle, where he lived the remainder of his life. In 2005 Archie played his favorite 5 number lottery pick in a combination of 10 tickets and won the Washington State Lottery. Archie was very generous, sharing a large portion of his winnings with family, friends and churches both in Seattle and Weed.

Archie is pre-deceased by his parents and younger brother Benny Ross Herring (1938 - 1939). He is survived by his brother: Robert Guss Herring Jr. (Cheryl); 1 niece: Michelle Renae Herring; and 4 nephews: Roy Sherman Herring; Kevin Lee Herring; Robert Guss Herring III; and Matthew Phillip Quentin Herring as well as many cousins and dear friends who mourn his loss and cherish their memories of him.
