Every year a Golf Outing & Fund Raiser is held in memory of Bob Kamppi, Jr. This event raises money for the Bob Kamppi, Jr. Scholarship Fund, which benefits youth bowlers from the local community. 100% of all proceeds and donations go directly into the scholarship fund.

It was Bob's dream to own a bowling center, and in 1995 that dream came true. Bob purchased R & R Bowl in Beloit, and later changed the name to Diamond Lanes. Bob always felt that the youth bowlers (ages 18 and under) were the most important aspect to the future of bowling and for a successful bowling business.

Bob also felt it was important for people to socialize during different events and activities. He hosted parties, took bus trips to baseball games and NASCAR races, and held numerous bowling tournaments at the center. But most important, Bob loved the game of golf. So in 2001, Bob started an annual golf outing at Diamond Lanes for anyone and everyone to participate in. It was an instant hit with patrons and friends alike.

Then tragedy struck. On the morning of May 8, 2002, Bob was killed in an automobile accident on his way home. This was extremely devastating to his family, and also to those who worked for him and frequented the bowling center. As it sadly turned out, Bob's annual golf outing was to be held the following weekend. It was during that event that the idea came to keep the event going and make it into something memorable.

Hence, the Kamppi Klassic Golf Outing & Fund Raiser was created. Participants play 18 holes of golf with chances to win prizes throughout the day; then attend a dinner following the golf portion of the event where more prizes are awarded. The Bob Kamppi, Jr. Scholarship Fund was also created, which benefits the youth bowlers of the Beloit bowling area. Through donations, sponsors, volunteers, and raffles, this event raises money to help the youth bowlers with the ever rising costs of attending college. 
