The following received from Susie Lee Jul 11 1998. She received from one Paul Martin the following documentation that Jonathan Anderson is the son of John Anderson and wife Honor:

"I have a reference for the will. The actual will is lost. However the man who had the will and lost it swore a deposition that he was familiar with all of the contents of the will and it he says that John bequeathed 18 shillings to each of his '8 children by a former wife' and then he gave the residue to be divided into three equal shares between his 'widow Honor Anderson' and his 'two sons by her William and Jonathan Anderson.' Honor to hold hers only for widowhood and to revert back equal shares to the sons upon her remarriage. This deposition approved on Oct 22 1790. It's the 'Early Records of Ga. Vol. Two Wilkes Co.' Editor Grace Gillam Davidson pg.194"

From "Early Records of Ga." -- Vol. Two Wilkes Co.: Editor Grace Gillam Davidson pg.194:

ANDERSON JOHN dec'd. Non-cupative will. Ezekiel Miller swears that in 1778 he saw John Anderson "of this state" sign etc. an instrument of writing as his last will his presence and the presence of three other witnesses to wit Thos. Roe, Michael Thomas and Richard Landsdale who also signed it that the said will made the time of the British Usurpation the said State and delivered into the care of Jos. Mattock of the said State that said Mattock says he lost it with other papers due the troublesome times. That the said deponent well acquainted with the contents of the will and present when such copy delivered to Barnard Heard Esqr. to be recorded. The said deponent says that after bequeathing 18 shillings each to his eight children by a former wife he gave the residue to be divided into three equal shares between his widow Honor Anderson and his two sons by her Wm. and Jonathan Anderson. Honor to hold hers only for widowhood. In case of her marriage the property consisting partly of slaves to revert to the two above named sons. Proved and approved Oct. 22 1790. Edward Jones R.P. Wm. and Jonathan took out letters of admn Oct. 22 1790. Ezekiel Benbrook, Daniel Runnels, Martin Armstrong apprs. Recorded bk. DD: pg. 78. Slaves Gabriel Isaac and Dinah.

From "The Wilkes Co. Papers 1773-1833" Davis REF GEORGIA 929.3758 WILKES COUNTY:

The following abstracts are from the Wilkes Co. Collection William R. Perkins Library DUKE UNIVERSITY. No information could be found at the Perkins Library on from whom or how these papers were acquired beyond the fact that they were obtained prior to Dec 10 1940 and a penciled-in note at the bottom of the 1784 appointment of HONOUR ANDERSON as administratrix that the document "Bought from Heise." Unlike the Greene Co. court records at the Perkins Library these of Wilkes Co. have not been microfilmed for use at the Ga. Department of Archives and History.

The loose Wilkes Co. papers collection at the Perkins Library are generally of only very limited genealogical value. Most are only court suits over debt or orders to sell the property of the defendants of these cases to pay the plaintiffs. When information of interest does appear a court case it is included the abstracts published here.

The Perkins Library has many other collections of interest to those researching individuals Wilkes and other Ga. counties. Particularly valuable are the thousands of state county and private papers their Miscellaneous Ga. Collection.

Will of Jonathan Anderson from Will Record A pp. 188-90: Will dated 23rd Mar 1837 recorded Jan 28 1838.

1. Plantation to wife Mary Anderson
2. A child's share to my grandchildren the children of Calvin and Phebe Downy viz: Reuben, Peyton, John, Samuel and Stephen Downy, Polly Hall, Betsy O'Neal, Ann Downy and Sarah Downy.
3. A child's share to Sarah, Martha, Milla and Elizabeth White--what their mother would have got.
4. One child's part to the children of my son William Anderson now dead.
5. To my sons Stephen Reuben John James and Jessee each a child's part.

From Minutes of Probate Court Book A & B:

- pg. 376: 04Dec1837 Jesse M. Anderson and Mary Anderson named the will of Jonathan Anderson as executor and executrix offered said will for probate. They gave bond for \$31000 with David Curry Stephen Anderson and Robert Pritchett as their securities.  
The court appointed the following to appraise the estate of Jonathan Anderson dec'd: Phillip Agee, Noah Agee, Obadiah Thomason, Jeremiah Pritchett and Henry Hare.

Minutes of Probate Court Book E:

- pg. 245: 21Mar1848 Court ordered that a citation issue to Jesse M. Anderson as adm. of Jonathan Anderson to appear next term of court and file new bond with other security order to release Robert Pritchett one of his present securities.
- pg. 260: 08May1848 Jesse M. Anderson filed new bond for \$1000.00 with R. B. Anderson and Henry W. Hatch as securities.
- pg. 474. 12Nov1849 R. B. Anderson one of the securities of Jesse M. Anderson as executor of Jonathan Anderson dec'd asked to be discharged from further liability as such. Jesse M. Anderson cited to give new security.

From Minutes of Probate Court Book F:

- pg. 147. Sep term 1851 Came Jesse M. Anderson executor and moved that satisfaction of the amounts decreed by the Court favor of Stephen Downey and Wm. H. Reed and wife Clarissa (formerly Clarissa Anderson) against him at the September term of Court 1839 be entered. Executor has fully paid off said decree. The receipts of Stephen Downy and of Wm. H. Reed and wife Clarissa showing that they had received their shares of the estate of Jonathan Anderson are recorded.
- pg. 152. Sep term 1851 Jesse M. Anderson resigned as executor of the will of Jonathan Anderson and moved that John B. Bruce sheriff of Marengo Co. be appointed administrator of the estate.  
The court appointed the following to appraise the personal property belonging to the estate of Jonathan Anderson: Ennis Loftin Hugh Goodwin John Baggett James W. Hall John Gildersleeve.
- pg. 161. 18Oct1851 John B. Bruce adm. petitioned the court to allow him to sell the real estate belonging to Jonathan Anderson dec'd. Court ordered that the heirs be notified of this petition.

- pg. 167. Nov1851 The administrator given permission to sell the 1851 cotton crop also the slaves and personal property not specifically bequeathed the will.
- pg. 227. Mar term 1852 Jesse M. Anderson late executor of the will of Jonathan Anderson filed his accounts for a final settlement of his executorship. Publication the Linden Free Press.
- pg. 249. Jun1852 Jesse M. Anderson turned over to John B. Bruce the balance his hands \$96.65.
- pg. 481. Feb1854 John B. Bruce filed his accts. for a final settlement of the estate of Jonathan Anderson. The court appointed F. W. Siddons guardian ad litem to represent the minor heirs at the hearing.
- pg. 503. Apr1854 The final account of John B. Bruce as adm. of the estate of Jonathan Anderson is allowed and ordered recorded. "See Final Record Book B. pg. 157."
- pg. 511. May1854 Stephen Anderson one of the heirs of Jonathan Anderson is now dead. He had assigned his share of Jonathan's estate to Reuben B. Anderson. The court therefore ordered that Stephen's share \$486.33 be paid to Reuben B. Anderson. N. B. Leseuer adm. of Stephen Anderson dec'd.
- pg. 522. Jun1854 Jesse M. Anderson filed the receipts of Phebe Ann Hamilton and of Jackson Pope and his wife for their shares of the estate of Jonathan Anderson.
- pg. 579. 24Nov1854 Joseph Agee filed court a power of attorney from Anderson Pope and Sarah J. his wife authorizing him to collect and receipt for their shares of the estate of Jonathan Anderson dec'd.
- pg. 642. 27Apr1855 Jesse M. Anderson filed the receipt of Eliza D. and James C. Etheridge for \$149.13 full of their share of Jonathan Anderson's estate.

Anderson, and Norris Bhael, son of Sam Bhael, both of Paris, were drowned at 1 o'clock yesterday afternoon at Hawkins' Shoals, Little River, twelve miles north of Foreman, Ark. Anderson was trying to save Bhael from drowning and both perished. The victims of the drowning with several others in three automobiles left Paris last Saturday afternoon to enjoy an outing on the river. Among the members of the party were the wife and mother of Lee Anderson and his wife's mother, Mrs. Webb; Van Anderson, Dennis Anderson, son of John W. Anderson, and several others. The first information of the drowning was contained in a message from Van Anderson to his brother, J. W. Anderson. The News received a telephone message after supper from E. M. Harris, a newspaper correspondent at Foreman, Ark. giving the details. He stated that Dennis Anderson, son of John W. Anderson, and nephew of Lee Anderson, and Norris Bhael were in bathing and unexpectedly got in water over six feet deep, which caused them to become excited. While they were in the act of drowning Lee Anderson, plunged in and went to his nephew's rescue. After bringing him safely to the bank he returned to rescue his companion, but the latter seized him and clung to his so tightly that both were dragged under and drowned. Lee Anderson, who lost his life in the performance of a heroic act, was the youngest son of Justice of the Peace F. M. Anderson, and was about 22 years old. He was married a few months ago to Miss Webb, whose father is a well known employee at the Frisco round house. Norris Bhael, the other victim, the son of Sam Bhael, was 17 years old and was popular among his friends. Both of the bodies were recovered and will be shipped to Paris this morning. John W. Anderson and Mrs. Ritchie Abshire, brother and sister of Lee Anderson and Sam Bhael, the father of the other victim, left in an automobile yesterday evening for Texarkana to meet the corpses.'
