ww.30Mar1672 Henry arrived as a headright in a land patent issued to Epharaditus Lawson, dated 22May1650. He received a land patent for 140 acres on 27Feb1656. He received 600 acres near Cedar Creek in Caroline County (formerly Essex County) in Apr1664. His will is dated 30Mar1672 and proved 1677 in King George County,Va. Both Henry and his son, Henry, were executors to the estate of John Butler of Westmoreland Co,Va. in 1676.

(note: the term "headright" referred to the practice of giving your allotted land to one who would pay your passage to the new world. So, although you were not a land owner, you were still a free man, unencumbered and not pledged to anyone.)

Will of Henry Berry Old Rappahannock County book, 1677-1682

I will and bequeath my soule to God from whom I have my first breath, my body to the ground to be buried in a decent manner. I will that my loveing friend Robert Peck be my sole executor that the said Peck may act in any case, as if I myselfe were in front. I will and bequeath to William Herton one hundred acres of land. I will that all the rest of my reall and personall estate be equally divided amongst my children except my wives thirds. To him that shall have the girle named Jane Stowe to have 2 cows more than the rest. I will that John Rolt have one heiffer two years old. I will that all my children may have a great care of the keeping of the said Jane Stow soe long as she lives. That my sone Richard may have learning as well as the rest, as witness my hand this 30th of March 1672.

"Joel Berry was born in 1754 in King George County, Va; and in his pension papers states he does not know the day or month of his birth, but it was written in his father's family Bible. His parents are not known, but from his pension records, we know he had a brother, William Berry, whom he served under in the Revolutionary War. Joel was drafted into the Militia of King George County and worked in the armory at Fredericksburg, Va. until about 1779. In 1780/1 he moved to Hampshire County and lived there another two or three years before leaving for Kentucky. Hampshire County tax lists show Joel was there in 1782. In 1783 he was issued warrants for 500 acres and 1,000 acres on Upper Howards Creek; 874 acres and 1,126 acres on Lulligreed Creek, all in Fayette County,Va. which was recorded in Richmond in 1788. In 1787, Joel is listed in the Bourbon County tax lists. 1798 tax lists showed he was in Mason County where he was granted lot #45 in the town of Washington for £2, and there he stayed until 1797, after which he appears on the Montgomery County tax list. In 1803, Joel and his wife Nancy sold 174 acres in Clark County to William Thornton; 60 acres to John Ranks and other land to John Congwright. By 1804, we find Joel in Pendleton County with two males over 21 years of age, William and Holeworth. Jesse Cayton bought 500 acres on Upper Howards Creek in Clark County in 1806, and where Joel is being taxed for 50 acres on the Main Licking in Pendleton County of that same year. Joel and William Berry are shown on Pendleton County tax lists through 1814 and then again on 1820-1826. Joel applied for his military pension in 1833 in this county in which he received \$80.00. Campbell County, Ky. Order Book 5, page 36 and 55 mentions Nancy Berry, wife of Joel, having died Nov1827 and Joel Berry, died 1843 Ruch County, Indiana with Rebecca Mullins, his only daughter, being sent his \$80.00 pension. Joel went to live with his son Holeworth in Rush County in 1840. Some believe he is buried in the Oak Hill Cemetery, but no stone was ever found. As a note to the validity of the name of his wife, no proof has been located on his marriage to Nancy Feagan as stated in the DAR Bible records nor of a wife named Ann Holesworth."

Enoch Berry Will State of KY Butler County 21 January, 1822

In the name of God Amen, I Enoch Berry of Butler County and State of KY considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory Blessed be to Almighty God for the Savior do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner for form following -That is to say first I give my soul to God who gave it 2. I give to my oldest son George Berry all my stock of Cattle which has been in his care for some years past that being his part that I a lot him. 3. I give to the heirs Enoch Berry Ten Dollars 4. I give to my daughter Nancy Covington Seventy-five Dollars 5. I give to my son Francis Berry Seventy-five Dollars 6. I give to my daughter Jean Thomaz Seventy-five Dollars 7. I give to my daughter Betsy Womack Ten Dollars 8. I give to my daughter Franky Bunch Seventy five Dollars 9. I give to my daughter Peggy Womack Ten Dollars and to said Peggyá™s oldest daughter Manerva my bed furniture all belonging to it. 10. I give to my four youngest sons (towil) Richard Berry, James Berry, John Berry and Presly Berry my plantation which I now claim lying on Big Muddy Creek, joining Thomas Barns William Carson the land to be equally divided between the four boys when the youngest comes of age. The plantation to be rented to the best advantage till the money is made from the rent to pay the other legatees And what other property I have to be equally divided amongst all my children. In (?) where of I herein do set my hand and seal this twenty first day of January 1822, I appoint my son in law Nathen Thomaz my son Richard Berry executors to this my will. (This next sentence is very hard to read and makes no sense) The words son berry and bunch are underlined before signed.

John Berry served as a Private under his father-in-law, Capt. William Smithers in the Dubois Battalion Mounted Spies. He was discharged at Shakertown, IN in 1812. John moved to Texas in 1826 as a Robertson Colonist and went to Liberty. On 02May1831, the Mexican government granted him one of the original town lots where he built a blacksmith shop. His 3rd wife, Hannah, was the grandmother of the famous War Hero, Audie Murphy.

BERRY, JOHN (1786-1866). John Berry, pioneer colonist, gunsmith, and blacksmith, was born in Louisville, Kentucky. He fought in the War of 1812. He moved from Christian Settlement, Illinois, to Blue Spring, Indiana, in 1816. Berry had three sons by his first wife, Betsy (Smothers), daughter of William Smothers, whom he married about 1810 and who died in Indiana; three daughters by Gracie Treat, whom he married on July 13, 1819; and twelve children by Hannah Devore, whom he married in Liberty County, Texas Republic, on May 8, 1831. In late 1826 he moved his family to the Atascosito District on the lower Trinity River in Texas. Mexico awarded him a lot in Liberty when it organized the municipality in May 1831. As a gunsmith, blacksmith, knifemaker, and furniture builder Berry qualified for the lot as an artisan. Sometime before 1834 he moved to Mina, later called Bastrop, where Mexico awarded him two town lots and a twelve-acre farm lot as an artisan. David Crockett, traveling on the Old San Antonio Road toward the Alamo, stopped at Mina while Berry repaired Crockett's famous rifle, Old Betsy. Berry's three sons by his first wife were Joseph, John Bate, and Andrew Jackson Berry. All three sons were Texas Rangers before and after the Texas Revolution, and all served in the Army of the Republic of Texas, and all fought in the battle of Plum Creek. Berry, his wife Hannah, and their small children took refuge at Fort Parker during the revolution, and upon returning to Bastrop found their home burned to the ground. In 1840 the family moved to the settlement that later became Caldwell in Burleson County, where they lived for the next ten years. The Texas Congress named Caldwell as the county seat in 1840, but the county was not organized until 1846. The Berry family was living there at the time. Berry applied to be a Robertson colonist on November 6, 1835, but did not settle on his league of land, located about three miles northeast of Georgetown, until the winter of 1846. He built a spring-driven gristmill, later called Gann's Mill, on Berry Creek. In 1848 he served as a commissioner, named by the Texas legislature, to organize Williamson County. For the fourth time, he was living in a Texas county seat when the county was organized. Berry was a member of the Church of Christ; his third wife, Hannah, was a faithful Baptist. Their home at Berry Creek was regularly used for Baptist services. Berry died on December 24, 1866, and is buried in a small family cemetery on the Berry league. His grave is marked by a plaque placed by the Daughters of the War of 1812. Five of Berry's sons and three of his sons-in-law served in the Confederate Army. His most distinguished direct descendant was his great-grandson Audie Murphy. On the grounds of the Williamson County Courthouse, the buhrstone from the Berry Mill is preserved beneath a state historical marker placed for Berry, whose descendants meet annually to commemorate the Berry family's service to Texas.

BERRY, ANDREW JACKSON (1816-1899). Andrew Jackson (Jack) Berry, ranger, soldier, and rancher, the son of Betsy (Smothers) and John Berry, was born in Monroe County, Indiana, on May 16, 1816. The family moved to Texas in late 1826 and settled in the Atascosito District. In 1834 Andrew moved with the family to Mina, later named Bastrop. He enlisted as a private in the Mina Volunteers on February 28, 1836, and fought at San Jacinto as a member of Company C, First Regiment, commanded by Capt. Jesse Billingsley. After the victory he extended his service until June. He was living in Houston when the town was first laid out. In 1838 he was living in what later became Caldwell, Burleson County, where the Berry family had moved after San Jacinto. With his brothers Joseph and Bate Berry, he fought in the battle of Plum Creek on August 12, 1840, under the command of Col. Edward Burleson. In 1843 he enlisted in Capt. Jack (John C.) Hays's Texas Rangers, and in 1846 he served at Goliad under Lt. John T. Price. Berry moved his family in 1847 to the future Williamson County, where the family was gathering on the Berry league on Berry Creek and the San Gabriel River. He served as a member of the first grand jury after that county was organized. He enlisted as a private in the Confederate Army and later served as captain in Archie Hart's company, Twenty-seventh Brigade. He joined the Texas Veterans Association when it was organized at Houston in 1873. He left Williamson County and was ranching in Lampasas County in 1876, but moved in 1881 to a ranch he purchased south of Baird in Callahan County, where he spent the rest of his life. Jack Berry married Rhoda Jane Hughes (1824-ca. 1866) on July 29, 1839; they had nine children. He married Mary Catherine Sloan on September 3, 1872; eight children were born of this marriage. In 1936 Mary Catherine was honored at the Texas Centennial celebration in Dallas as the last surviving widow of a San Jacinto veteran. Berry died on July 31, 1899, in Baird when his team of mules, frightened by a train, ran away and he was thrown from his wagon. He is buried in the Ross Cemetery at Baird, where the state of Texas placed a marker for him as a veteran of San Jacinto.
