

COGIN FAMILY

THOMAS m. **JOAN** (-) (d.Nov1695, she m.(2) Obadiah Millerd) d.04Mar1653/4 Taunton,Bristol,Ma.

Thomas died intestate, and inventory of his estate being made by George Hall and Richard Williams, totalling £23/8, exhibited to the Court by the widow Joan on 23Mar1653/4.^[2,3] On 05Oct1661, Joan Millerd petitioned the Plymouth Court to sell that part of her late husband's estate belonging to and in relief of her daughter, Bathsheba.

D. **RUTH** b.ca1651 Taunton,Bristol,Ma. m.24Jun1675 Samuel Taylor (s/o Jonathon & Mary Taylor) at Springfield,Hampshire,Ma.
