HENGES STATUES OF Va., VOL. 8., PAGE 132, THOMAS OF LOUDOUN COUNTY WAS PAID FOR A RIFLE GUN IMPRESSED BY THE MILITIA 1757. SIX YEARS LATER 1763, LT. OF LOUDOUN WAS PAID FOR 60 DAYS PAY. THOMAS WAS LISTED AS LT. THE FRENCH AND DIAN WAR. Va. QUIT RENTS: 1761, 1769, 1771, AND 1772.

" ON THE MOTION OF SARAH , WIDOW AND RELICT OF THOMAS , DECEASED AND HER MAKG OATH ACCORDG TO LAW, CERTIFICATE IS GRANTED HER FOR OBTAG LETTERS OF ADMISTRATION ON HER DECEASED HUSBAND'S ESTATE, SHE HAVG ENTERED TO AND ACKNOWLEDGED BOND WITH SECURITY AS THE LAW DIRECTS".

Will of Joshua Gorr, of Loudoun Co., Va.

... to my son, Thomas Gore, five shillings, he being already provided for... ..

to William Osborne my negro girl, Winney...

to my daughter, Betsey, my negro girl, Hannah...

to my wife a bay mare which I got from Timothy Howell last Fall and two cows...

to my wife the sheep which she brought on this plantation...

to my wife all the goods and effects whatsoever I became possessed of in consequence of my marriage with her and effects which she became possessed of by the death of her former husband, Harry Rector... excepting such articles as I have paid for to the Ex'ors of Harry Rector's Estate...

I give and bequeath to my sons, Joshua and Jonathan Gore, to be equally divided between them, the following negros: Jude, Harry, Janney, Jam, Will, and Warner...

my two sons Josua and Jonathan to be my Executors... to sell the plantation whereon I now live...
