Can I make a donation in person?

Who will distribute these funds?

The funds will be administered by Minnesota Indonesia Society and distributed to the Red Cross-Indonesia, Doctors Without Borders, and/or other reliable international relief agencies.

Is my donation tax deductible?

Yes! The Minnesota Indonesia Society is a 501 (C) (3) not-for-profit organization, registered in Minnesota. Donors may deduct contributions to this organization provided in section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code.



On Sunday, December 26th 2004, a massive earthquake occurred off the west coast of Aceh, Sumatra, triggering deadly tsunamis (tidal waves) that killed tens of thousands of people and devastated coastal cities and villages in Indonesia and 11 other countries in South East Asia. Millions of people have been displaced in this region and are without access to clean water, food and proper sanitation. The destruction and number of victims have been disproportionately higher in Indonesia, due to the country's proximity to the quake. Relief agencies must act quickly to protect the health of survivors and begin rebuilding in the region. Your contribution will help ensure that these efforts are successful.
