# From the Vicarage

## Faith Schools Part II

*It is why we want more good faith schools for parents and pupils who want them.*

*Theresa May Speech*

*Conservative Party Conference October 5<sup>th</sup> 2016*

Now that the question of Faith Schools has been taken up by the Prime Minister as well as her Education Secretary I feel the need to return to the topic again this month in order to elaborate on why it is that I am so opposed to any faith schools in the United Kingdom.

Last month I gave something of the background of Faith Schools and suggested that as the United Kingdom moves from a predominantly Anglican country to a rich and varied multi-cultural one dividing our education system into an increasing number of different Faith Schools is not conducive to building a common culture.

To further elaborate this point: there is so little that unifies us as citizens of a common nation that fragmenting the education system still further does not seem that wise to me. How can young people learn to experience the richness of different traditions if they do not grow up together? The reality of Faith Schools is that is extremely unlikely that religious families, of whatever tradition, would choose for their child a school of an alternative Faith tradition; and if secular families are unwilling to choose Anglican Schools for their child what chance is there that they would choose one of the minority Faith Schools? The upshot is that Faith Schools, particularly in towns and cities, will become more and more SINGLE Faith Schools. The result then becomes more and more narrowing, rather than broadening, of the educational experience.

I would argue that to live, work and grow up amongst a wide variety of traditions will build closer bonds between different communities. As a result the common bonds that unite us as citizens of the United Kingdom and an adherence to those values that we hold so dear will be strengthened by the end of Faith Schools.

Secondly, politicians argue that Faith Schools tend to provide better results. A major factor for this is that the systems for getting into Faith Schools, particularly in cities, seem to have been purpose built to favour ambitious middle class parents. There are Faith Schools in this country occupying sites in deprived neighbourhoods where the majority of the pupils come in from outside, attracted by the 'quality' of education, while those who live nearest have to travel to schools further afield because their parents are not so adept at 'playing' the application process. Should a government committed to improving opportunities for all really be increasing opportunities to discriminate against the most disadvantaged in our society?

Thirdly, Christianity is a religion that has grown out of a tradition of speaking 'Truth to Power'; that is confronting those in power with the implications of their actions regardless of cost. Jesus was the ultimate example of this and paid for his outspokenness with his life. Throughout its history the Church has been most potent in bringing about change (slavery, [in 1807 all the Bishops voted in favour of the slave trade] civil rights, female emancipation, opposition to homophobia) when, initially, a few speak out against

the institutions of power and oppression. So should a religion proclaiming that true freedom is found in the weakness of the child born in the stable who grew up to be crucified on the cross continue to side with the exercise of power and the reward of privilege as represented in our Faith Schools?

The Church must imitate Jesus and the great men and women of our tradition and be willing to step back from its seat at the tables of power, be it Faith Schools or the right to automatic membership of the House of Lords, and call for justice and equity across the whole of society, including in the education system, from outside. The efficacy of its witness has to be based on its truth and authenticity and not on an unhealthy historical association with power. We need schools where children of all faiths can live and learn alongside one another in an atmosphere of tolerance, love and respect. These are the core values of all religions as well as being those values that our society should be doing all in its power to instil in its young people. Unity of opportunity and not fragmentation has to be the way forward.



## **A Personal View - by Vera Ricketts**

### Memories of the River

So many happy days and nights, we, as a family, have shared down the river. One of my fondest memories was eeling with the children and Gordon. The best time to go eeling was during heavy rain and thunder. I have no idea why, it just was!

The children and I would very slowly walk into the river in a line and then start walking through the weeds making as much noise as we could, moving towards Gordon, attempting to scare the eels. Once we got close to him he would pull the cage from the water to see if we had been successful in catching any eels. Any smaller eels were let go and swam off to freedom, however this was rarely needed as they were able to mostly escape through the wire in the cage.

We would continue moving down the river. Once we had caught them, Gordon would take them from the cage and hand them to us in an old rag as they were too slippery to take in our hands, we would then place them into a bucket with a cloth over the top that had a hole in it, held on with red string (every farmer had this in his pocket), to prevent them from getting out.

Once we had caught enough, we would head home across the fields and once home Gordon would prepare them for eating. This would include cutting them into small two inch pieces, from there I would be responsible for cooking them. To do this, I would first put some flour into a bowl then roll the pieces in it then put them into a frying pan with hot oil and fry them till they were nice and crispy and yummy. In truth I remember the children never actually ate a single eel but they sure had fun catching them, Gordon enjoyed eating them though!!

Another fond memory of the river was a time I remember where David, Keith and the rest of the village boys went down to do a spot of fishing. Whilst strolling through the river, as they had done so many times previously, they came across a conger eel. To this day we have no idea how it got into the river but the poor beast was dead. That being said this didn't stop Keith posing for a photo with it before they placed it back into the river.

So many river and fishing stories to tell, but I don't want to bore you too much. Something Fishy going on Haha!!!!!!





As I have travelled around the village recently I have noticed that a lot of hedges and bushes are protruding over the pavements and walk ways, and causing issues at road junctions. One would be a combination of Bournemouth and Poole possibly plus Christchurch and even maybe East Dorset, and the other the rest of Dorset. Currently, the more favoured option is for East Dorset to join the rest of Dorset. Pleased keep an eye in the local press and also the web for further information regarding this as it affects us all and it is very important.

## English Usage, a personal view by Michael Evans

### Doublespeak

People in power or authority will at times try to lull us into believing that things are better than they really are, so we need to be aware of *doublespeak*.

The word has been around since the 1950s and is a blend of two other words coined in George Orwell's book 1984, *doublethink* and *newspeak*. It describes words with which the speaker or writer deliberately seeks to hide his or her true meaning. In 1973, a US committee on doublespeak said it was "language which tries to make the bad seem good, or to avoid responsibility."

A press release from a factory reporting an *escape of biosolids* meant that raw sewage had leaked from the system. A company offering *job flexibility* may be disguising the fact that it does not give permanent contracts. Some *job seekers* may already have a job and wish to change, but the term is often used by government because they think it sounds more positive than *the unemployed*.

*Ethnic cleansing* is supposed to make you feel better about genocide, while military terms like *friendly fire* and *collateral damage* are supposed to make it excusable that they killed their own soldiers or civilian bystanders.

It's a little easier to discern the true meaning of doublespeak, as in the last two examples, when they are used so often that we smell a rat and they lose their force.

On a lighter note, I came across an innocuous example of doublespeak recently when the loser of a chess match announced that he had *come second*.




### Re-imagining Wimborne Minster's Medieval Past

Where in Wimborne Minster might you have found a Cord Wainer, a Fletcher and a Horn Carver? On the historic Leaze of course!

Today part of the Deans Court Estate, in the 14<sup>th</sup> century the Leaze was an ancient suburb of Wimborne with homes and businesses. The system of medieval streets is still clearly visible in the well-preserved earthworks on this exciting archaeological site. Businesses of the time are likely to have included a Fletcher (arrow maker), a Cord Wainer (shoemaker), Horn Carver, Blacksmith, Thatcher and Skep (bee hive) maker amongst other trades.

Now local residents and visitors can discover how this historic high street might have looked in medieval times thanks to a wonderfully evocative illustration by local artist Pamela Shrubbs. Together with text by landowner Sir William Hanham and local historian and author Janet Seal, the image has been used on a new interpretive panel unveiled this week by Vice Chairman of East Dorset District Council Cllr Derek Burt.

At the suggestion of Sir William Hanham and local historian Malcolm Angel, the information panel to explain the Norman Medieval Suburb on the Leaze was created as one of the legacy projects of the inaugural Wimborne History Festival. Both the Festival and this particularly project have received support from the Heritage Lottery Fund, Wimborne BID, East Dorset District Council, Wimborne Minster Town Council and the Wimborne Civic Society. The Festival is a biennial event and will return in 2018, ideas for future community legacy projects are welcomed.

In the meantime those with an interest in the town's heritage can see the colourful and informative new sign on the lane leading to the Cricket Club off King Street to the rear of Wimborne Model Town.

## **Facebook account takeover, PayPal and WhatsApp fraud**

**Action Fraud has received several reports from victims who have had their Facebook account hacked by cybercriminals who have then sent messages to their friends asking for a favour relating to PayPal.**

### **How does this fraud work?**

Fraudsters are hacking victims Facebook accounts through unknown means and then changing their password and phone number.

The fraudsters then message the hacked victims' friends to ask them to receive payments through PayPal for various reasons. They then ask for their phone number so they can communicate through WhatsApp.

The fraudsters then convince the victim to receive funds into their PayPal account and transfer them into a bank account of the scammers choice.

A chargeback is then initiated through PayPal, leaving the PayPal account holder out of pocket as they have already sent the money to the fraudster's bank account.

PayPal say on their website: "A chargeback happens when a buyer asks their credit card issuer to reverse a transaction that has already cleared. This can mean that a payment you've received in your PayPal account could be reversed, even if you've already posted the goods – which can of course be frustrating". PayPal will help you as much as possible if you wish to dispute a chargeback, but the final decision lies with the credit card company. However, you can also get protection with PayPal's Seller Protection policy".

### **One victim lost £3,800**

In one report, an initial message sent through Facebook read: "Hey, I know it sounds random but do you have a PayPal account? I sold something on Ebay".

After the victim replied, the fraudster said: "Can I send you my bank details on Whatsapp. I have changed my phone so send me your Whatsapp number and I will message you there".

Another victim reported receiving £3,800 into her PayPal account and then transferred it into a bank account of the fraudster's choice.

### **How to protect yourself and what to do if your Facebook account has been hacked**

- If you receive a suspicious message from a friend on Facebook, contact them via other means to check the message is genuine.
- Create a strong password. Use three words which mean something to you but are random to others - this creates a password that is strong and more memorable. You should change passwords often and never use the same one twice.

"This year is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Springdale opening so a community event was a great way to start our year of celebrations."


Julia's House community fundraiser Laura Kelly donned her running vest to join the children and help them in the pre-mile warm-up.



## Camellias and their care - by Lys de Bray

The garden centres will have fine healthy-looking camellias in stock now which make excellent Christmas presents. Should you be given one which is in bud or actually in bloom, here are some notes to help you to keep it as happy as it was when it arrived. Camellias came originally from China and the tea that we drink so much of is *Camellia sinensis sinensis*. Camellias should not be allowed to dry out especially when the flower buds are beginning to form in late summer. Pruning if necessary is best done in the dormant season (dormancy is slightly different according to the type of camellia - check label at time of purchase and see below) or it can be done immediately after flowering.

### Williamsii and allied hybrids

These plants are good for beginners; They flower more freely in areas of low light intensity and because they have smaller, tougher leaves they can tolerate more extreme weather conditions.

### Japonicas

These generally have larger glossy leaves and in exposed positions they can be frost-damaged. Most need some shade.

### Camellia reticulata

Varieties can have huge blooms but are best grown under glass or in a poly-tunnel except in Devon and Cornwall, though there are exceptions.

### Camellia sasanqua

Varieties are autumn-flowering and scented. Most are best grown with some protection.

## USEFUL NOTES ON CARE AND CULTIVATION.

Avoid planting large-leaved camellias in exposed and windy positions.

Camellias flower from September through to end of June, February/ March is the best period. Feed larger leaved camellias with Vitax for Conifers, Rhododendrons/azaleas (same) Never feed with animal manure.

Top-dress in April and again in July or apply Osmacote in autumn.

Camellias can be hard-pruned and moved, even if in flower in March/April. Use an anti-transpirant or spray with water (not ice-cold) in hot weather.

Camellias can be grown as bushes, standards, hedging.

Plant large camellias in September, small ones in spring.

Roots are very vulnerable to frost, beware root-scorch. Roots in containers should be insulated with bubble wrap (large bubbles) or a bin-liner filled loosely with straw and tied round pot.

Use Nimrod T as a fungicide when/if necessary.

Ideally, water with rain-water.
