Three Full Shows on Saturday and Sunday including Showmanship (first show only), Wethers, NPGA Does and NPGA Bucks, Master Champion classes, and classes for unregistered does and bucks. There will also be 3 KGBA sanctioned Kinder Goat shows.

The North Carolina Pygmy Goat Club would like to invite you to the Festival of Pygmies show at The Windmill Lakes Event Center in Liberty, NC on November 11-12, 2017. We are excited to offer NPGA Sanctioned classes as well as unregistered classes for those that would like to participate. We welcome spectators as well as exhibitors to join with us in the show. Pens will be provided.

SCHEDULE

We will begin with show #1 at 9 AM with Corey Christoffersen judging. Show #2 with Bryson Staley judging will begin probably after the lunch break. Show #3 will follow with Josh Leidig judging. Show #3 may be concluded on Sunday morning, time to be announced. The order of the shows will be SHOWMANSHIP (show 1 only), WETHERS, UNREGISTERED DOES, NPGA DOES (with Doe Master Champion Challenge class), UNREGISTERED BUCKS and then NPGA BUCKS (with Buck Master Champion Challenge class). Banquet, Annual Club Meeting with Election of 2018 officers will be on Saturday evening at approximately 5:30 PM.

SHOW RULES

NPGA rules will govern all NPGA classes. Per NPGA show rules, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that their animals are entered in the correct classes. *Please do not send in entry forms without class numbers listed for your goats.* Any NPGA animal over 6 months of age must be tattooed or microchipped prior being shown in a sanctioned NPGA class or wether class according to NPGA show rules. All goats entered in the NPGA sanctioned classes must be accompanied by their NPGA registration certificates. Registered wethers should also have their registration certificates accompanying them. Unregistered wethers can be shown in the wether classes. Unregistered does and bucks may only show in their respective unregistered conformation classes. Goats bearing the judge's herdname may not be shown under that judge.

ENTRIES

Entry fees are \$8.00 per goat/per class payable to NCPGC. (No charge for showmanship.) ***Entry deadline is November 8, 2017 to be in the showbook.*** Substitutions and late entries will not be included in the printed program, but are welcome. Age computation for classes is based on the age of the goat on the date of the show.

PENS

Pens will be provided for this show at \$8.00 each. They are approximately 4 x 8 feet. There are separate buck and doe/wether sections. Please indicate how many of each type pen you will need.

CHECK IN and ARRIVAL TIME

Check-in and arrival may begin Friday November 11 after 2 PM. Friday check in from 5 to 7 PM. Saturday check in from 8 to about 8:45 AM.

ULTRASOUND PREGNANCY CHECKS

Have your does checked for just \$10.00! Bryson Staley will be doing pregnancy checks. Does should be 45 days bred or more. Club to receive half of the fees collected.

SATURDAY LUNCH, BANQUET

Homemade soup and bread will be available for \$5.00 for lunch on Saturday. If you care to bring a soup or other item for lunch, please get with Donna Staley to coordinate. Our banquet will be catered this year by Donna Staley and Lisa Salmi. Cost per person is \$10.00.

SILENT AUCTION

There will be a Silent Auction during the shows on Saturday. It will close shortly after the conclusion of the second show. Please make a donation of items for our auction; this is one of our major fundraising events for the club.

EDUCATIONAL CLINICS

There is a free showmanship clinic planned for Friday evening. It will be approximately 45 minutes. Also a blood draw clinic is to be held sometime on Saturday and for a small fee payable to Lisa LaRose. Contact Lisa LaRose at 618-615-2629 for what you will need to bring to store blood until it can be mailed. Your goats can be drawn and you can send to the lab for testing. Please specify on your entry form the number of goats you want to have blood drawn on so enough tubes can be brought to the show. Time permitting we may do a grooming clinic Friday evening.

HEALTH PAPERS/RESTRICTIONS

North Carolina import laws will apply. NC requires health papers for animals being brought from out of state for sale or exhibition. Please check with your veterinarian for the exact requirements. Exhibitors from NC are not required to have health papers to show in-state. Please do not bring sick animals to the show.

SPONSORSHIPS

We welcome any sponsorship of the classes in the show. You may sponsor any number of classes for \$5.00 each. You may wish to dedicate your sponsorship to a favorite goat, a special goat mentor, etc. You get a free business card ad in the showbook with each class sponsored.

DIRECTIONS

FROM I-85/US-70

Take I-85 S/US-70 W to NC-49 S/Maple Ave in Burlington, exit 145 (31.9 mi). Turn left if coming from the east, or right if coming from the west onto NC-49 S/Maple Ave. Continue to follow NC-49 S (17.9 mi). Turn left onto S Fayetteville St (0.2 mi). Take the 2nd left onto S Greensboro St. (0.9 mi). Continue onto Old US Hwy 421 (0.8 mi). Turn left onto Overman Rd. (0.3 mi) to 7377 Overman Rd.
