Pens will be provided for a small fee.

SCHEDULE

We will begin with show #1 at 10 AM with the second show starting after finishing the 1st show with breaks for lunch and to complete championship paperwork. The hosting club Banquet will be on Saturday evening at approximately 5:30 PM. Depending on timing and the size of the classes, the 3rd show may be able to be held on Saturday but most likely it will be Sunday morning and if so would begin at 9am.

SHOW RULES

KGBA rules will govern all classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that their animals are entered in the correct classes. *Please do not send in entry forms without class numbers listed for your goats.* Any KGBA animal must be tattooed prior to being shown in a sanctioned KGBA class or Chevron/wether class according to KGBA show rules. All goats entered in the KGBA sanctioned classes must be accompanied by their KGBA certificate of merit/registration certificates.

ENTRIES

Entry fees are \$8.00 per goat/per class payable to NCPGC. (No charge for showmanship.) ***Entry deadline is October 21, 2018 to get an initial count. Those received by the deadline will be included in the showbill.*** Age computation for classes is based on the age of the goat on the date of the show.

PENS

Pens will be provided for this show at \$8.00 each. They are approximately 4 x 8 feet. There are separate buck and doe/wether sections. Please indicate how many of each type pen you will need.

CHECK IN and ARRIVAL TIME

Check-in and arrival may begin Friday November 9 after 3 PM. Friday check in from 4 to 6 PM.

ULTRASOUND PREGNANCY CHECKS

Have your does checked for just \$10.00! Bryson Staley will be doing pregnancy checks. Does should be 45 days bred or more. Fees will be paid to Bryson Staley at time of ultrasound.

Night time security will be provided by Lisa LaRosa and Kelsee Gibbs.

SATURDAY LUNCH, BANQUET

Homemade soup and bread will be available for \$5.00 for lunch on Saturday. The evening dinner banquet will be catered by club member and the cost per person is \$10.00. Banquet Menu normally consists of good ole country cooking with pie for dessert. This is a great time of fellowship.

SILENT AUCTION

There will be a Silent Auction during the shows on Saturday. Lots of great goat items! Donations are welcome and not just goat related items.

EDUCATIONAL CLINICS

There may be several clinics at the show. As of now there is a pack goat clinic to be held by John James.

HEALTH PAPERS/RESTRICTIONS

North Carolina import laws will apply. NC requires health papers for animals being brought from out of state for sale or exhibition. Please check with your veterinarian for the exact requirements. Exhibitors from NC are not required to have health papers to show in-state. Please do not bring sick animals to the show.

SPONSORSHIPS

We welcome any sponsorship of the classes in the show. You may sponsor any number of classes for \$5.00 each. You may wish to dedicate your sponsorship to a favorite goat, a special goat mentor, etc.

NCPGC CLUB MEMBERSHIP

If you would like to join the NC Pygmy Goat Club, please enclose \$15.00 for first time members or \$25.00 for returning members. You can indicate on your entry form that you are joining or re-joining NCPGC. The club sends out a nice quarterly newsletter with lots of helpful information. Also upon joining you get a really nice welcome packet with articles on disbudding, vaccinations, dewormers, etc. It is wonderful and well worth the money. It is applicable to more than just pygmys.

FROM I-85/US-70

Take I-85 S/US-70 W to NC-49 S/Maple Ave in Burlington, exit 145 (31.9 mi). Turn left if coming from the east, or right if coming from the west onto NC-49 S/Maple Ave. Continue to follow NC-49 S (17.9 mi). Turn left onto S Fayetteville St (0.2 mi). Take the 2nd left onto S Greensboro St. (0.9 mi). Continue onto Old US Hwy 421 (0.8 mi). Turn left onto Overman Rd. (0.3 mi) to 7377 Overman Rd.
