Level One - Voting / Working / Exhibiting Artist Member	\$135.00 - show and membership fee
Level Two - Voting / Working Artist Member	\$15.00 - membership fee
Level Three - Exhibiting Guest Artist	\$160.00 - show fee

Voting Members

- are expected to participate in the operation of the group and attend monthly meetings.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be the designer, creator and producer of the art/craft sold at the show. The work must be original, well conceived, expertly executed without technical faults and show an identity of design.
- NO manufactured items are allowed in the show. Our foremost interest is that the items are made by hand.
- Articles made from molds are acceptable only where the mold is the design and product of the artist or craftsperson or where the mold is subordinate to the maker's creativity.
- Any article in any media using a commercial kit is automatically disqualified.

Display

Tables and chairs are available. Tables need to be skirted to the floor. All other display materials must be provided by the artist.

Selection

Exhibitors are selected by a jury from submissions of 5 photos of recent work, plus a personal profile. Include an image description document that identifies each image and includes size, medium, year produced and retail price. **Pictures will be returned providing your self-addressed envelope is large enough and bears sufficient postage.**

Booths

Due to the odd shapes of the rooms, spaces will be approximately 100 square feet. No booth sharing is allowed. No booth displays over 8' tall.

Set-up and Clean-up

Exhibitors shall set set-up Friday night. Clean-up will begin at 5 pm on Sunday following the show closing.

Electricity

Is available, artist shall supply lights and extension cords.

Pricing

At One Stop Studio Tour, we believe in the value of hand made work. To maintain this integrity, items are not to be displayed as sale, discounted or reduced.

Sales Taxes

Exhibitors are required to collect and remit all appropriate taxes.

Demonstrations

Each participant is asked to demonstrate some aspect of his or her art as part of our mandate to inform and educate the public. A demonstration can be photographs or a video of you in your studio at work and some raw materials for people to touch.

All Exhibiting, Non-Exhibiting and Guest Artists

Everyone will be expected to participate in set-up and clean-up and the "Walk and Drop" of the neighbourhood.
