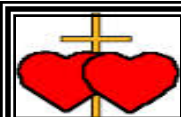

Reading for next Sun., Sept. 7, 2014

Theme: We are called to help one another grow as a community of faith.

Breaking Open the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing: Gospel Mt 18:15-20

Jesus said to his disciples: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother. If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, so that 'every fact may be established on the testimony of two or three witnesses. If he refuses to listen to them, tell the church. If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector. Amen, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Step One: Listen to the Word-When you hear the Gospel proclaimed today, what words or phrases really strike you? What lingers in your memory from this reading?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: What is one thing you would do for someone whom you loved?

Question for Youth: Jesus tells us about the importance of community and friendship. When have you helped heal an argument between friends? How did that feel?

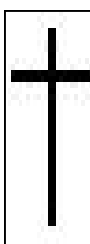


Every year, we conduct a SPECIAL FRIENDS Campaign that had been a major source of revenue for our school. Now this campaign will serve as a major source of financial help for the parish. The funds raised by this campaign will be used exclusively for the benefit of the parish to help us thrive in the many programs we offer and to help cover the costs of maintaining parish operations. Even though we are still in summer, fall and winter are coming upon us. It will be cold once again. This year we are putting in a new burner to service both the new and old school buildings which will benefit our Religious Education program, other parish activities, plus our nursing school. This burner will cost approximately \$54,000. Your support is greatly needed.

The drawing will be held at the annual Parish Picnic on Saturday, September 6, 2014 (immediately following the 5pm Mass) with five (5) cash prizes awarded that day: \$3,000 \$2,000, \$1,000 and two (2) \$250. Winners need not be present to win and will be notified.
