October 2, 2013


***WHEREAS**, the **Global Peace Walk** project was initiated in 1995, walking from New York City to San Francisco celebrating the United Nations 50th anniversary by offering the prayer for “Global Peace Now!” as the universal human resolve; and*

***WHEREAS**, the **Global Peace Walk 2013** will be conducted from Santa Barbara departing on Mahatma Gandhi’s 144th birthday, October 2, 2013, to the United Nations in New York City, arriving on the June 26, 2014, 69th anniversary of the initial signing of the UN Charter whose express purpose is “to remove the scourge of war from the future generations”; and*

***WHEREAS**, the reason for walking from Santa Barbara to San Diego as the starting point for this year’s walk across country is to bring out the “90 for Life!” message for human health about the 90 essential nutrients required for health and longevity. The pioneer scientist who discovered the identity of these 90 essential human nutrients has his California company headquarters in the San Diego area.*
