Capoeira Angola is an African-Brazilian martial art form— fluid, rhythmic art, a ritual, a dance of deceptive vulnerability, wit and grace. Capoeira stems from an era when enslaved Africans in Brazil used it to combat the colonial oppression. Like many African based traditions, Capoeira is an art form that is orally transmitted from masters to students.
