Dear Fellow Laborer,

Greetings to you from Croatia! We are so excited that summer is behind us. The work here really suffers in the summer. Already we have began some of our fall meetings and this has helped the Church to go forward. During the last two months we have had some ups and downs, but through it all God blessed!

Our first big day in the fall was Harvest Sunday. We had 31 in attendance with 1 first time visitor, and with 1 saved! Kruno is a young man that was brought to church by his cousin. After the meeting I sat down with him and told him the Gospel story, it was so wonderful to see him trust the Saviour.

Last month was difficult for me. My Grandmother Doris Miller, passed away, and we could not make it back for the funeral. I was very close to her and will miss her a lot. When I was on furlough we tried to make it by her house as much as possible. She was a big Dallas Cowboys fan and it was fun to watch a 76 year old woman get that excited. We thank the Lord for the time that He allowed us to have her.

Our church is still continuing our soul-winning programs. It is great to see our people get excited about soul-winning. Brother Alen is my soul-winning partner and he is getting so excited about it that he thinks we have to go everyday. Because we have two churches going we are going three times a week. Since our last letter we have had 6 saved. Soon we will be starting a new soul winning ministry and we ask you to pray with us about it. While we were out knocking doors we passed by a flea market close to our church in Varazdin. We learned that anyone can rent a booth for \$1.00. This market is packed with people every Saturday morning. We have decided that we are going to rent a booth and give out tracts and free Christian books. Please pray that through this ministry many will be saved.

The Bible project is continuing on. The men are getting close to finishing the New Testament, we are looking at about 2-3 months. They are continuing on with the Old Testament as well. I am still praying for a miracle. As I mentioned in our last letter we have about \$500.00 coming in monthly and our monthly expenses are about \$1,300.00. We are using the surplus we had and it will last until February. I believe God has showed many times that He is for this project, and I believe He will provide for this need.
