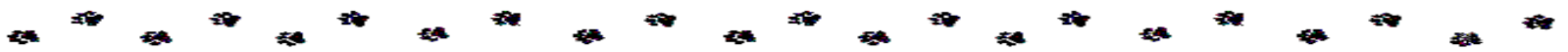

Registration Costs

Registration Fees include

Camp facilities, firewood, ice. For the day / days you are registered for. RV sites are additional fees. Tent camping and includes all non-fee classes. Bring your own camping gear!

Daily Registration

\$65.00 per DAY. Includes meals for the day / days you are registered for.

Event Registration

\$200.00 includes all meals and registration for the entire event

Class fees

The up to date current class list will be posted on the web site. Some classes have an additional fee. You must be registered for as many days as the class runs.

On-Site Registration – Additional \$10.00

RV / Camper / Utility Sites:

Requires pre-registration and are on first come basis. Registration is thru SAR-EX ONLY. Do not contact the Campground. Sites include Water, Electric, Cable and Sewer. \$25.00 per Night. We do allow tents on these sites you do not have to have an RV. You must be registered to be on an RV site.

Tent sites

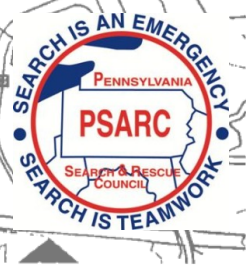
Tent sites in lower camp area have electric and water. Sites are assigned at check in, and are first come basis. There a couple of small group sites in the lower camp area if teams or groups would like to camp together.

Meals for Non-Participants / Guests:

For family members and friends who come out that are not participating. Meals per person / per day. \$45.00

General Conference Information

Drinking Water

Drinking water is available at several areas in the camp, There will be bottled water and containers of water for the K9's. at the remote training stations. Make sure you have your own water supply.

Showers, Etc.

There are showers & bathrooms available in several areas of the camp. Soap and towels are the attendee's responsibility.

Laundry Facility

The Laundry is Located next to the Camp Registration office. These are coin operated and soap and etc are the attendee's responsibility

Camp Amenities

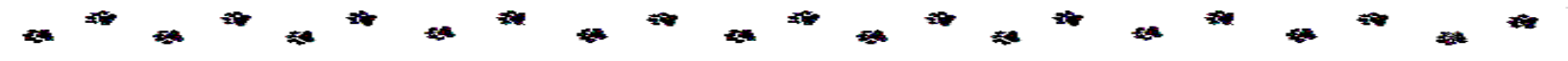
As its name states this is a campground, all attendee's are responsible for their own camping gear. Most sites have water and electric and / or are in close proximity.

Medical Emergencies

During our event we will have emergency medical personnel on hand. Several of the Staff & Instructors are EMT's, Our Event Medical coverage is provided by the Lancaster Emergency Medical Services. They will have paramedics, a special Operations trailer and Gator. In case of an Emergency contact a staff or and Instructor or see the Registration office.

General Conference Information

ID Badges

Please wear your conference ID badges at all times while participating at the conference. It is required for entry into classes and for meals.

Traffic

Please limit vehicle traffic while on site. Speed limit is 5 mph for all motorized vehicles in the campground.

Communications

Report any problems immediately to conference staff. Call 911 in the event of an emergency.

K9 Reminders

***You are required to show current Rabies Vaccination records for all dogs that will be on site. Your dog will not be allowed on site with out these records.**

***Aggressive behavior will not be tolerated. Any K9 that misbehaves must be removed from the event.**

***Dogs Must be on leash and under control at all times**

***Please Pick up after your dogs, this is the responsibility of the handler, Doggie Do-Do cans can be found in the upper and lower camping areas**

*** Dogs WILL NOT be allowed in food lines or dining areas.**
