## **Final Project Choices**

**Choose ONE of the following:**

- 1) Create a book jacket for the book. On the front of the jacket are the title, author, and an illustration. On the back is the author's picture and/or positive comments from reviewers and a summary of the book. On the front inside flap, the publisher usually prints a brief summary called a blurb which sometimes continues onto the back flap.**
- 2) Draw a comic strip of an important scene in the book. Your strip must include at least 6 boxes. Drawings must be accompanied by either character dialogue within the boxes or a summary explaining the drawings outside of the boxes. See me for the template.**
- 3) Write a diary from the perspective of Willy Wonka. This should include his personal feelings, how he spends his time, and commentary on the happenings in the factory or world. There must be at least 5 entries with at least 5 sentences in each. Let us into the crazy mind of the world's greatest candy maker.**
- 4) Design a board game that includes many of the rooms from Wonka's factory. You must include game pieces and written instructions.**
- 5) Create a promotional brochure advertising several of Wonka's candies. The brochure should be folded into thirds with pictures and information about Wonka's specialties.**

**6) Write a prediction of what will happen to Charlie in the future. You may wish to include other characters from the book as well. This may take the form of a story or play.**

**7) Write a summary of the book in the form of a new Oompa Loompa song. This must be similar to the songs in the book in that it rhymes and is about the same length.**

**8) If you have another great idea for a final project, let me know. I may allow you to come up with your own!**

**Guidelines:**

- **Projects must be completed using your personal best work. Do not quickly complete the project just to get it done.**
- **Parents may help, but this is your project. Projects should reflect your hard work and energy.**
- **Some class time will be given, but the majority of the project must be completed at home.**
- **Be creative. Take your time, but don't wait to the last minute. Have fun!!**
