In the text of your paper:

When citing a source within a paper you will need to include a citation at the end of the sentence, including the author and page number the first citation (Ison 21). **or,**

Within the same paragraph, if you have not cited another source, you may just cite the page number each additional citation (21).

In your Works Cited list:

Book

Last Name, First Name, and 2nd Author's Name. <u>Title of the Book</u>. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year.

Journal Article

Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Periodical</u> Volume (Year): Pages.

Newspaper or Magazine Article

Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Periodical</u> Day Month Year: Pages.

Book Article or Chapter

Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Book</u>. Ed. Editor's Name. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year. Pages.

Encyclopedia Article (well known reference books)

Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Book</u>. Other Information. Year.

Encyclopedia Article (less familiar reference books)

Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." <u>Title of Book</u>. Ed. Editor's Name. Volume. Place of Publication: Publisher, Year.
