

Introduction

This book documents ancient prophecies from every major religion that prove that a new world religion is true. This religion is destined to bring world peace. These prophecies foretell a time when science and religion would unite to transform the world. Thus this new faith is also authenticated through cutting-edge scientific and archaeological discoveries. These include revolutionary new evidence that the Bible is true. At a time when popular books have titles like *The God Delusion* and *God is Not Great: How Religion Poisons Everything*, and at a time when most colleges indoctrinate their students with atheism, the spiritual truth that can transform the world has been unveiled. Ancient evidence from Egypt, Palestine, Sumeria, and Mesoamerica confirms the truth of important scriptures, so the world can then unite under them and under God.

Why has spirituality been rejected by so many? The main reason is the onslaught of attacks made on the Bible in the last two centuries. But the tide has turned. The Bible and other scriptures are now uniting with science. The world will thus unite under these scriptures. The prophecies in these scriptures and in other sources point to the new world religion. Mankind will unite under this religion and bring about the Most Great Peace.

At present, the Bible is linked with excessive guilt, repression, and theocratic abuse of power. Thus this prevents many from believing in it. People are wary of the many so-called Christian governments that have abused their power over the centuries. Another problem is that many false interpretations of the Bible exist, whereas another problem is that there are many bad translations of its text. These problems imply that the Bible conflicts with science, even though science agrees with the original biblical text. This book alone documents this. It is unfortunate that these false interpretations and translations have led many people to reject religion and the existence of God.

Most scientists accept the following statements about the Bible. Such statements have led many to reject the Bible and God: The universe was not created in just six twenty-four-hour days. (This book accepts the theory of evolution but with a groundbreaking new perspective.) The earth was never a paradise without death. Eve could not have been created out of Adam's rib. The biblical patriarchs, such as Adam and Enoch, could not have each lived for hundreds of years. There was no global flood. There was not one language throughout the world at the time of the Tower of Babel. The Red Sea did not part with a wall of water hundreds of feet high on either side of the Israelites, as they fled from the army of Pharaoh. There is no evidence that the conquest of the Promised Land by the Israelites happened during the Late Bronze Age, which is where the Bible places it on the standard chronology. The earth did not stop rotating for one day at the time of Joshua.

The good news is that when these Bible stories are properly translated and understood they are remarkably supported by science, history, archaeology, and linguistics. The innovative information in this book, including that about Holy Books other than the Bible, corrects the most significant false interpretations and translations of the Bible. It also shows that the Bible has been accurately preserved since it was written thousands of years ago. No other book covers this cutting-edge information.

The truth is that this book will revolutionize the science versus religion debate. A major world paradigm shift is imminent. This book outlines new evidence for true religion that can continue to be tested by future scientific experiments, whereas the religious claims made by most scholars are untestable. The truth is that naturalism now shows that God exists.

Much of this information has never been introduced to the general public. The first reason for this is because most of these discoveries are quite new, and the second reason is because they have never

before been brought together into one coherent argument. Many of these discoveries are understood by certain scholars. But these breakthroughs have not yet worked their way into the general scholarly and non-scholarly communities. And discoveries that challenge the status quo always encounter great resistance. New light, in many instances, must break forth out of darkness.

The next three paragraphs give some very specific previews of what this book documents: For instance, it proves that pain exists because God made mistakes. He had to learn and evolve. Once enough people learn that God evolved, it will revolutionize our understanding of the universe. A proof that God was not always perfect is that the same inability to do wrong that He had would have been given to all life. The absence of such perfection proves that God evolved. It has now been proven that God evolved through sacred geometry from simpler to more complex. Pure mind created all things. This is supported by many scientific experiments, which have shown that consciousness continues after death and that miracles, or magick, are real. This includes new research into near-death experiences, prayer studies, intelligent design, psychic phenomena, and remote viewing. (Understand that in this book stage magic, with its use of illusion, is distinguished from real magick, or miracles, by the addition of a “k.”)

This book shows for the first time that the Sumerian King List and the Bible both date Noah’s flood to 2910 B.C. The fact that the worst Mesopotamian flood since civilization began is radiocarbon dated to about 2900 B.C. proves that the biblical flood did happen. The story in the Hebrew should be translated to say that the flood was local and that the ark landed on a hill, not on Mount Ararat. The Hebrew words the Bible uses to refer to the animals taken onto the ark thus refer only to mammals and birds from the land of Sumer.

The world needs to understand that ancient Mesopotamian records mention Adam and Eve by name and date them to about 4000 B.C. It is amazing that this agrees with the biblical date. The Hebrew shows that Adam was not the first human. He was the first man in the sense of being the first civilized human. The Garden of Eden was the temple garden at the Sumerian city of Eridu. When interpreted correctly, the story of the serpent and the divine one in the garden is seen to be a literal account of a Sumerian temple ritual involving nudity and two symbolic trees.

Many other amazing new discoveries about the Bible are documented in this book. But this does not mean that everyone should rush out and become a Fundamentalist Christian. This is because there is also exciting new archaeological evidence for other Holy Books. Two very important parts of this book are Chapters 8 and 9. They document the ancient prophecies from every major religion that prove that a new world religion is true—the religion destined to bring world peace. These prophecies are not vague: They mention specific dates, names, places, and events; indeed, they were given to us by God to unite us in the end times.

The foundation stone of this book is the newly revealed geometric proof that God exists, which was kept secret by ancient Egyptian priests and was meant to come forth when the world was ready for it. This geometric proof is incredibly powerful. When the world knows that God exists, it will unite under Him.

Since the rise of science from the seventeenth century onward, any agreement between science and religion has been increasingly difficult to find. Even as recently as ten years ago, the information needed to harmonize science and religion was not available. But now, with the help of the Internet, one can discover that research in many areas is bringing these two fields together. Information separated by great distances is now brought together instantaneously. This is thus helping many revolutionary facts found in libraries, magazines, research papers, books, brilliant minds, and even nature herself to be pulled together for the first time to bring about world peace. Faith, which can be placed in anything, will no longer fight faith. This is because, although faith is a very important part of the process, it will be transformed into knowledge, and knowledge does not conflict with itself.

We have just entered a new millennium, and according to many Christians earth is soon to enter a thousand year period of harmony, melodious beauty, world peace, and righteousness. Yet, some still claim that we will never be given scientific proof that our spiritual beliefs are true. This is not only unfortunate, but it is also not in keeping with what we know of God's coming kingdom. It is certain that, to bring heaven to earth, God will have to give mankind much more scientific knowledge and many new technologies: Could it be true, then, that we will be given the power to perform miracles? Will we eventually be as angels, with the ability to walk through walls or hover above the ground? During the Millennium will magick be used? Will there still be natural disasters, disease, and accidents? Later, in the following chapters, these questions will be answered along with many others.

Unfortunately, in the effort to create world peace, time is not on our side, for serious national differences still threaten us. Just consider the large amount of resources wasted each year on war. Although the loss of human life is by far the most terrible cost, the physical resources wasted is also a very serious problem. We could certainly use human life and natural resources for far better purposes than killing each other, causing destruction to cities, and intimidating other countries through show of arms.

Although a worldwide dictatorship, with its inevitable abuse of power, should never be allowed to happen, it is clear that a worldwide spiritual democracy is the only solution to our international problems. (More often than not the majority will make better decisions than the few—especially with universal education.) This worldwide democracy will come about after an International Constitutional Convention is organized and convened. This convention will then draft a World Constitution outlining a balance of powers and a Bill of Rights (call these whatever you will). And this will finally allow an effective worldwide reduction in military. Trillions of dollars a year will then flow to health care, scientific research, technology, quality of life, and other such worthy endeavors.¹

How do we create a world with at least a majority of peace-loving, good governments? The main way to do so is through information, whereas military force should only be used in defense or to stop genocide. The spiritual truth taught should embrace modern science without contradictions, setting an example of compassion towards the peoples and nations of the world. We will not try to spread dogma and blind faith. In the future, true spiritual teachings will not be recognized and embraced solely due to a spiritual feeling, or through biased conviction or fanaticism. (It must be understood, however, that God's Spirit and love can touch our hearts in powerful ways, and this is different than a mere feeling.) Only when science strongly supports a spiritual system will the people of the world universally accept it, and that is the way it should be.

Nevertheless, in this process, the United States and other such nations must demonstrate better the virtues of democracy and human rights. In fact, it is very important for such nations to set a much better example than they have in the past, so that other countries will see such virtues fully implemented. This is important since many countries equate freedom with moral degradation, crime, and social chaos, and indeed, at present there is some truth to such arguments.

This whole process should be unimpeded by any form of *iron curtain*. Too many religions tell their people to, "Just read things that agree with the Faith." No wonder so many churches are convinced that they are right and that all others are wrong. It must be understood that in the near future shielding oneself from contrary views will no longer be necessary, since those contrary views that will remain will concern primarily minor details.

We might hope that our religion will be the star of this change. The truth, however, is that all the good religions and all people have their own unique truths to share with the world. Using biblical teachings, this book reveals the revolutionary fact that all of the great religions were started by true prophets of God. It was not until later that men added falsehoods to them—often even taking what is symbolic as literal. We must admit that God loves all people. We are too often self-righteous because we think that only people in our religion will go to heaven. But what kind of a God would send most of His children to hell forever?

The truth is that spiritual beings over thousands of years have been gradually raising the level of mankind's spiritual understanding. God, in His wisdom, revealed truths to the prophet founder of a major religion about every 600 years to help mankind in this process. These truths were given in a manner that was applicable to the understanding, time, and place of those to whom they were given. But, you must understand, there is an immense wall that separates the physical worlds from those that are spiritual; thus, the transformation of mankind could not have happened all at once. There had to be gradual progress over the centuries.

This will eventually unite the physical world with the heavenly realm. The reason God, the archangels, and angels cannot manifest much on earth yet is probably because of our lack of faith. This suggests that our negative thoughts create a wall that keeps divine beings out. This explains why God has not come to the earth in full view of mankind through the media. It seems that He can only manifest to those with enough faith. As more and more people come to believe in miracles, greater and greater miracles will happen. Miracles will also happen more and more often.

Everyone should know that their help is needed for these truths to transform our world. This should be done through example and also through natural and friendly discussion with others or via the written word. Every person who reads these pages is investing in the future. The words "transform our world" do not mean an end result of sterile and dull rigidity—but instead—a future full of rich color, peaceful security, and excitement. Never should beauty, humor, art, and/or love be sacrificed to reach peace. We also do not need another religious regime or godless state; instead, in the future, the positive aspects of all cultures, people, and religions will be loved and respected.

It must be understood that just because everything a religion teaches is not true does not mean that God cannot inspire those within it. This is true because a person can receive revelation from God in one instance and then become out of tune with the Spirit in another. However, this does not invalidate the earlier revelation. If we do not understand God's fairness and love towards all good religions, the paranoia and presumptions of fanaticism will continue to fracture and divide. It is also a mockery to the intelligence of others and to God's loving concern to see the spiritual experiences of our religion as of God and all others as of Satan. It must be understood that, despite the imperfections present in various religions, in the end one cannot take over at the expense of the others; instead, the various religions will teach respect for each other's prophets, truth, and beauty—and toss aside any errors.

The truth is that ignorance is the cause of all misery. People do wrong because of darkness (ignorance) in certain areas of their understanding. For instance, problems on the job happen when we are ignorant of how to do our work correctly, and, in a similar manner, moral problems arise out of an ignorance of how to live correctly. We thus need to understand eternal consequences, the worth of all people, the joy of doing what is right, the reality of spiritual realms and forces, and so on.

Unfortunately, many pessimistic Christians claim there is no way to avoid a near total

destruction of the planet—including its people, animals, and plant life. They claim that there will be no true world peace until after Jesus returns physically from the heavens. Nevertheless, people who claim such things have misunderstood the Book of Revelation: for it can be read verse by verse in a way that makes much more sense than such purely futurist interpretations. The truth is that there is evidence that most of the terrible things read into the Book of Revelation will not happen, that is, at least if mankind repents. Thus there are far better interpretations of its pages than the belief that nothing can keep us from a nuclear World War III. It must be emphasized again that the terrible things people read into its pages might be taken as a warning that if we do not turn to God they will happen.

Peace is on the horizon. And so, instead of fighting each other, let us fight ignorance, hunger, heart disease, strokes, cancer, AIDS, other diseases, and so on! May God bless you in reading this book. It does not give all the answers to the problems of the world; indeed, many of the answers it presents have been around for thousands of years. Nonetheless, most of the other answers came either from a meticulous synthesis and sorting out of facts from the work of other scholars, or from revolutionary discoveries that I myself have made. It becomes clear, then, that these ideas cannot be the possession of a few. They are meant to be given to everyone so that the planet may be transformed into a world of light.
