Record #153 James Johnson - On 8 March 1789, I, the undersigned pastor of Mobile, solemnly baptized in Cornelius McCurtin's house, James, born on 21 ____ 1788, legitimate son of John Johnson and Joyce Powell, Anabaptists, Natives of North America and residents of the Tensa River. Godparents were Joseph Thompson and Maria Joseph Juzan.
