If she can purchase it by the time is Required that it should be payd for and if she is nat able to purchase it by the Exoiration of the time I do leave it to her Discretion who in the Family shall purchase it. I do also give all the remaining Part of my estate to my Loving Wife intil my young son Benjamin shall arrive to ten years of Age. (Excepting one cow that I have already given to my son William) and then to be equally divided between my Daughter Francis, My Daughter Jane, My son Archibald, My Daughter Anne, my Son Joseph and my son Bejamin, Excpeting my Wives Thirds.
