

Indenture (Deed) of Elizabeth & James Powell ; (Conveyance: to N Paramore) ; This Indenture made the sixteenth day of February in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred & three Between Elizabeth Powell & James Powell Executors of the Last will and Testament of William Powell deceased of Washington County & Mississippi Territory of the one part & Noah Paramore of the State of Georgia & Scriven County of the **Indenture (Deed) of Elizabeth & James Powell (Conveyance: to N Paramore)**

This Indenture made the sixteenth day of February in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred & three Between Elizabeth Powell & James Powell Executors of the Last will and Testament of **William Powell** deceased of Washington County & Mississippi Territory of the one part & Noah Paramore of the State of Georgia & Scriven County of the other part Witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred dollars in hand well and truly paid by the said Noah Paramore at & before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold aliened; enfeoffed & conveyed & by these presents do bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff & convey unto the said Noah Paramore, his heirs, Executors, administrators & assigns one certain Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & fifty acres, lying being and situated (in) the county of **Effingham & State of Georgia** on the south side of the Great Ogechee River having such form shape marks as appears by a plat-annex to a Grant granted to Thomas Blackman on the third day of January one Thousand seven hundred & sixty-nine, bounded on all sides by vacant land at the time the survey was made - together with all and singular the ways the warters mines minerals, advantages heredo aments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Revision & Revisions, Remainder & Remainders thereof & every part & parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land of One hundred & fifty acres & all & singular the premises herein before mentioned & intended bargained & sold hereby & every part & parcel thereof with their & every of their appurtenances unto the said Noah Paramore, his heirs Executors, administrators & assigns the said Elizabeth Powell & James Powell themselves their heirs, Executors, administrators & assigns do for ever warrant & defend, firmly & fully by these presents freely & voluntarily. In testimony whereof the said Elizabeth Powell & James Powell have hereunto set their hands and affixed their respective seals this sixteenth day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen

hundred & three.
