- ➤ Planned community/campus service for the future (including plans for an alumni and faculty banquet);
- ➤ Been visited and received recommendations from the Eastern Province Grand Praetor Harvey Silverman; and
- Recently gained some influential and positive awareness from Hopkins' Dean of Arts and Sciences.
