## Virginia Beach Hawks History

The Virginia Beach Hawks Fastpitch Softball Organization was established in 1999. The vision of the founding members was to provide quality training to talented female softball players who wanted to work and train harder in order to compete at the higher level of tournament softball, and thus the 12U Hawks team was born. It was made up of 5 coaches and 18 players, these first players were hand chosen for their ability and desire to play softball.

In 2000 the Hawks expanded to a 14U and 12U squad and in 2001 we added the 10U to the Hawks family. By this time the Hawks were well on the way to establishing themselves as a dominant team in the tournament softball arena.

2002 was a banner year for the organization as we expanded to add another team, the 16U. With this addition the Hawks came of age in tournament softball. We became one of the "Big Dogs" on the block with 4 teams (16U, 14U, 12U and 10U), being one of the largest organizations in the area. It was also the Hawks year on the softball field, "bringing home the hardware" from tournaments in all age brackets. Every Hawk team in the organization finished second or third in multiple tournaments. It truly was the "Year of the Hawks".

2003 promises to be even better than before. We have added an 18U team. This allows the Hawks to be a competitive

powerhouse at all the top tournament age levels. All the teams are sure to bring home numerous first place finishes in the upcoming 2003 tournament season, this accomplishment will catapult the Virginia Beach Hawks to the "Top of the Heap" in competitive fastpitch softball.

The Virginia Beach Hawks have 50 girls age 10-18 who have dedicated themselves to the task of becoming the best athletes, role models and future leaders of our communities that they can be. The coaching staff of the Hawks is made up of 12 dedicated coaches who have the daunting task of teaching the youngest players the fundamentals of the game to preparing the older girls to enter their high school softball program and ultimately to be NCAA softball players. This 2003 tournament season will be exciting and fast paced. The organization will play in 51 tournaments locally as well as up and down the east coast.
