Metzgar has been the
winner of 13 awards for
promotion of such artists
as Kenny Rogers (So In
Love With You ASCAP
1981 Capitol Records),
for Diana Ross and
Lionel Richie, (Endless
Love, ASCAP 1981
Motown Records), Billy
Joel (Just The Way You
Are, 1977 CBS/SONY
records-Columbia
Records Hall Of Fame)
Charlie McLain (Just
One Look In Your Eyes
– Tapadero Music BMI
Publishers 1986 on
CBS/SONY Records),
and these 16 major label
Acts: Bandana (Warner
Brothers Records),
Sawyer Brown (Capitol
Records) Carl Butler
(CBS-Columbia
Records) Lee
Greenwood, Emmy Lou
Harris, Alan Jackson,
Carl Jackson, Warner
Mack (MCA Records 23
million in sales) and
Tommy Overstreet (MCA

Sales), Johnny
Paycheck, Billy Walker,
and the Smokey River
Boys (4 RIAA certified
Platinum Albums) and
has recently produced
the Smokey River Boys
“O Brother” album from
the movie of the same
title.

Mr. Metzgar has
either promoted,
produced for television
or produced in the studio
some of Nashville’s
greatest superstars.
Nominated Producer of
the Year every year he’s
been in the business by
a trade magazine such
as Cashbox, Billboard,
CME Magazine, Country
Parade or Country
Weekly,

Mr. Metzgar was
a winner of the
prestigious Popular
Music Awards by
ASCAP International in
1991. The awards for
Mr. Metzgar’s artists are
a list of Who’s Who in
country music. Mr.

Metzgar has produced
the Cashbox Male
Vocalist Of The Year,
Duet Of The Year,
Female Vocalist Of The
Year and has been
nominated Label Of The
Year and Songwriter of
the Year by many
organizations and
societies both here and
Internationally. Mr.
Metzgar exclusively
writes for Walt Disney
Music Co (ASCAP) in
Hollywood, California.
He has written songs for
shows at Opryland,
Disney World, and
Universal’s theme park.
Mr. Metzgar has
produced many great
symphony projects such
as Bobby Enriquez’s
Jazz Piano’s Greatest
Hits Album. The Wild
Man Phillipino’s Jazz
Concerto Album, Prince
Mandera’s International
Love Affair album and
others.
Movie theme and score
writer for the IBM
Corporation’s Dare To

Dream series and movie project, Mr. Metzgar's involvement in major corporations has made his production company one of Nashville's most eminently qualified for the development of new projects for the marketplace.

Mr. Metzgar's publishing company, the Aim High Music Company is now owned by Zomba-BMG Publishing in Hollywood. His label, Platinum Plus Nashville is distributed by a major label, Universal in Hollywood, California. The publishing company has been awarded 13 gold records and 11 platinum records through the past 12 years of music related sales on various artists and songs. Mr. Metzgar also currently owns Club Platinum Music (BMI) and is a partner in Bobby & Billy Music (BMI). Platinum Plus Universal holds the record for having some of the highest charted national hits in the Bluegrass Billboard Charts. The song, "O Brother" has been in Top-40 Billboard for over a year and the album sales of the project have been in the charts over 2 years and the combined sales of O Brother product have surpassed 7.5 million copies in the past 12 months. Mr. Metzgar was a recent Co-

producer of the Black Gospel Group Of The Year and has many of his songs, as well as those in his publishing company recorded and released nationally that have been charted in various trade magazines such as Radio & Records, Billboard, Gavin, and Cashbox.

Mr. Metzgar manages and does promotional work for a limited number of extremely outstanding clients who are developing their careers with major record labels in Nashville, New York, and Hollywood.

He was voted the Producer Of The Year in 1993 at the MIRC awards by country radio during CMA Fan Fair week of June 1993. He was nominated for a Grammy award in 1993 for his outstanding work as a producer in Black Gospel music.

Winner of ASCAP's prestigious popular music awards in 1991, 1992, and 1993, Mr. Metzgar's mother was also a songwriter for Broadman Press in Nashville and is the writer of the world famous gospel hymn, Jesus Breaks Every Fetter. Voted into the Billboard's Who's Who in Country Music Production in the years 1993-1997, Mr. Metzgar was the top recruiter for membership in the CMA

(Country Music Association) in Nashville for 1993. He has had a song he produced for television or radio in the Hot Country Singles Charts every week for 8 years and was voted Cashbox Magazine's Producer of the Year for years 1993-1995. Mr. Metzgar is the only producer in history to have ever had 11 single releases all with bullets in the Hot Country Singles Charts in the same week February 10th, of 1994. He has been elected to the Legends Hall Of Fame and the Academy Of International Recording Artists Hall Of Fame. Mr. Metzgar works as music producer for MCA Universal and serves in an advisory capacity for various other major labels, publishing companies and projects. He was elected to "Who's Who In Entertainment" in the year 2000" and the Smokey River Boys were elected to the Legends Hall Of Fame in Branson in 2003. Mr. Metzgar is prominently mentioned in the official autobiography of Garth Brooks entitled, "American Thunder" which is published by Random House, he is also the author of two books, "Artist Survival Manual" and "You Are The Greatest." A motivational and

marketing expert, Mr. Metzgar continues to produce and write for his select client list and sign acts to his label in Nashville. He has judged the Miss America, Miss USA, and Miss Universe contests as well as participated as a judge for Star Search, and other television shows. His television production skills in Nashville are mentioned in many of the autobiographies of Nashville superstars from the TNN (The Nashville Network) days of television.

In the year of 2005, Mr. Metzgar was nominated by radio, the members of the Texas Music Commission and the public as "Texas Producer Of The Year," for his work on the Jen Rathbun jazz album entitled, "Coffee, Chocolate, & Men." That album was rated the #1 album at Amazon.com and also garnered a "Female Vocalist Of The Year" nomination for jazz star Jen Rathbun from Houston, Texas.

In addition to the many production activities, Mr. Metzgar has also been heavily involved in the development of various Broadway musicals such as Judah Ben Hur, The Orphan, and Magdalena. Metzgar's entrance to the Broadway scene was with another Disney

writer and producer of such musicals as The Lion King & Beauty & The Beast. Don Frantz, who is considered one of New York's most prestigious Broadway producers, partners with David & Ellen Sanborn Metzgar and others on the Judah Ben Hur project and with Warner Brothers in a 3 year runaway success in Singapore, Hong Kong and Tokyo.
