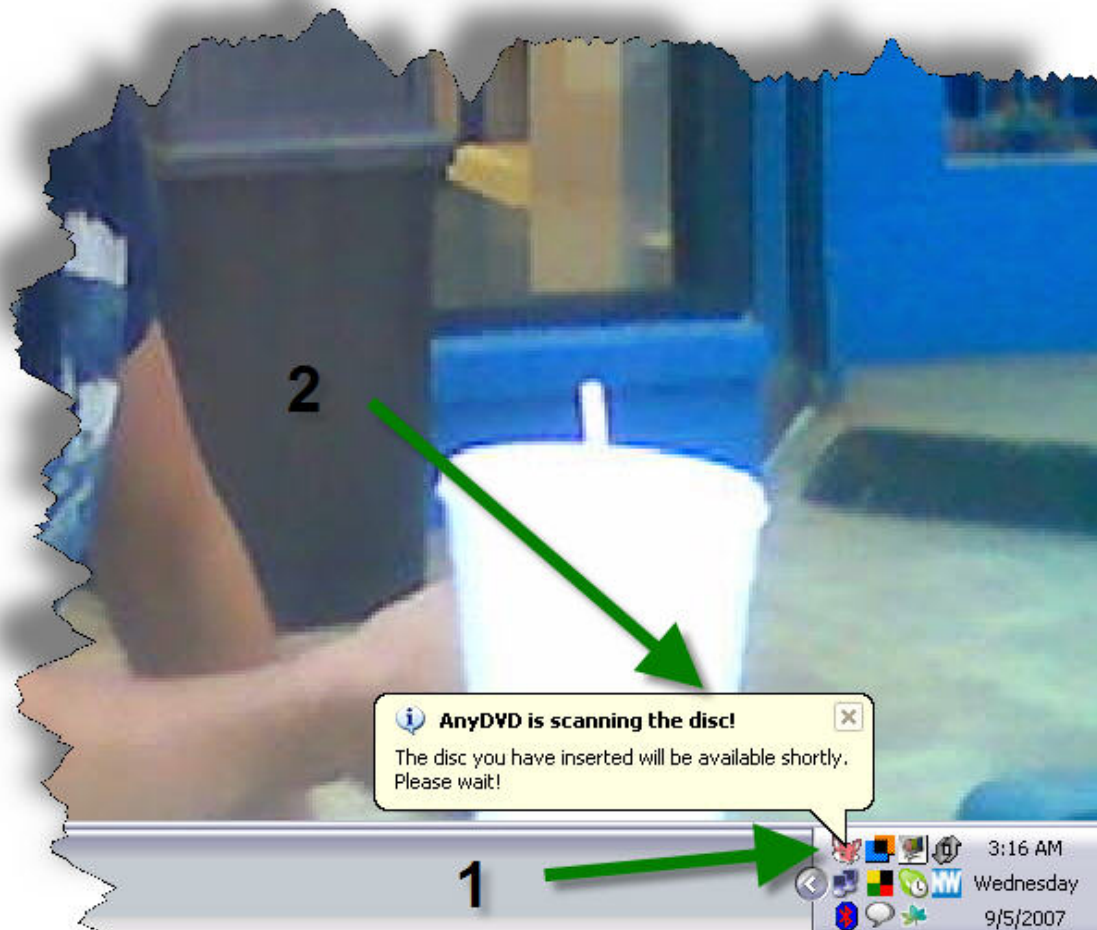
# And



## To copy from Disc to Disc

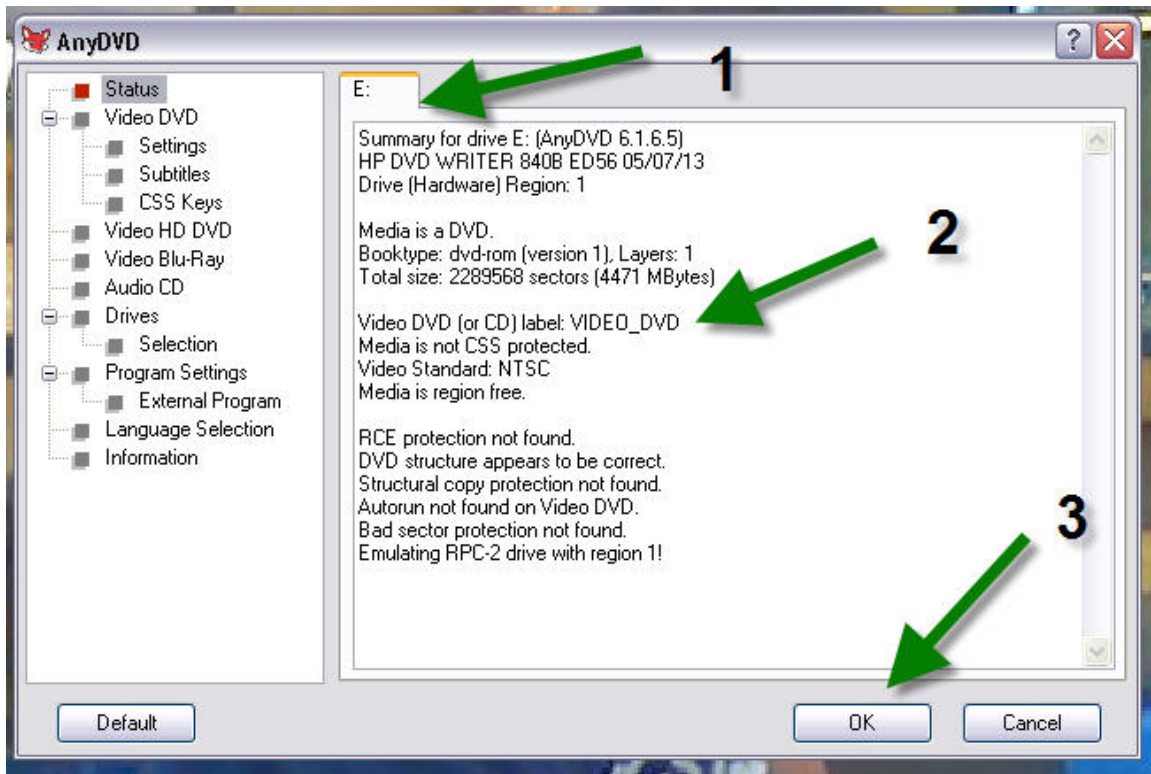
**First put the disc you want to copy in the Drive.**

**Then wait you will see this box:**



- 1. you will see the little fox head turn pale.**
- 2. this box should pop up.**

**Once this process completes this box will pop up**



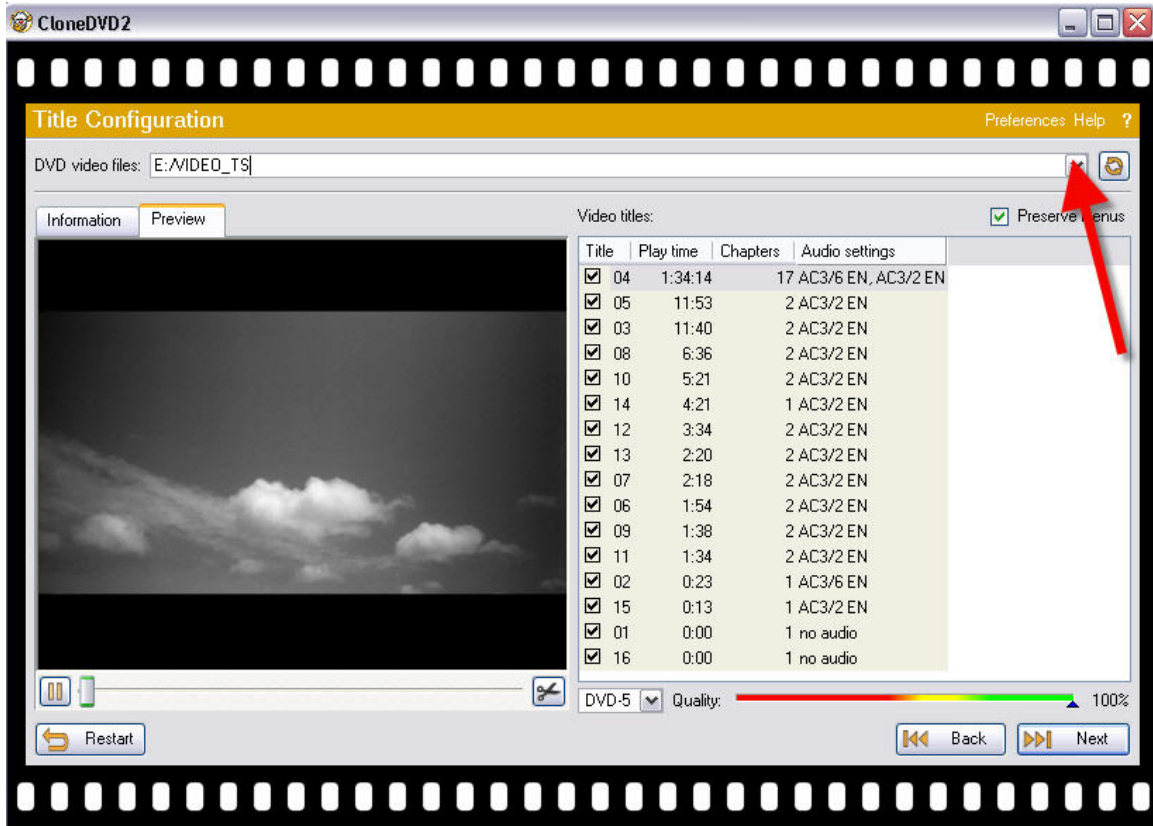
- 1. This should be the drive letter in which you placed the disc.**
- 2. you will more than likely see the name of the movie here.**
- 3. Just hit OK and this box will close.**

**Now go ahead and open CloneDVD.**



**The red arrow indicates the box to copy a DVD**

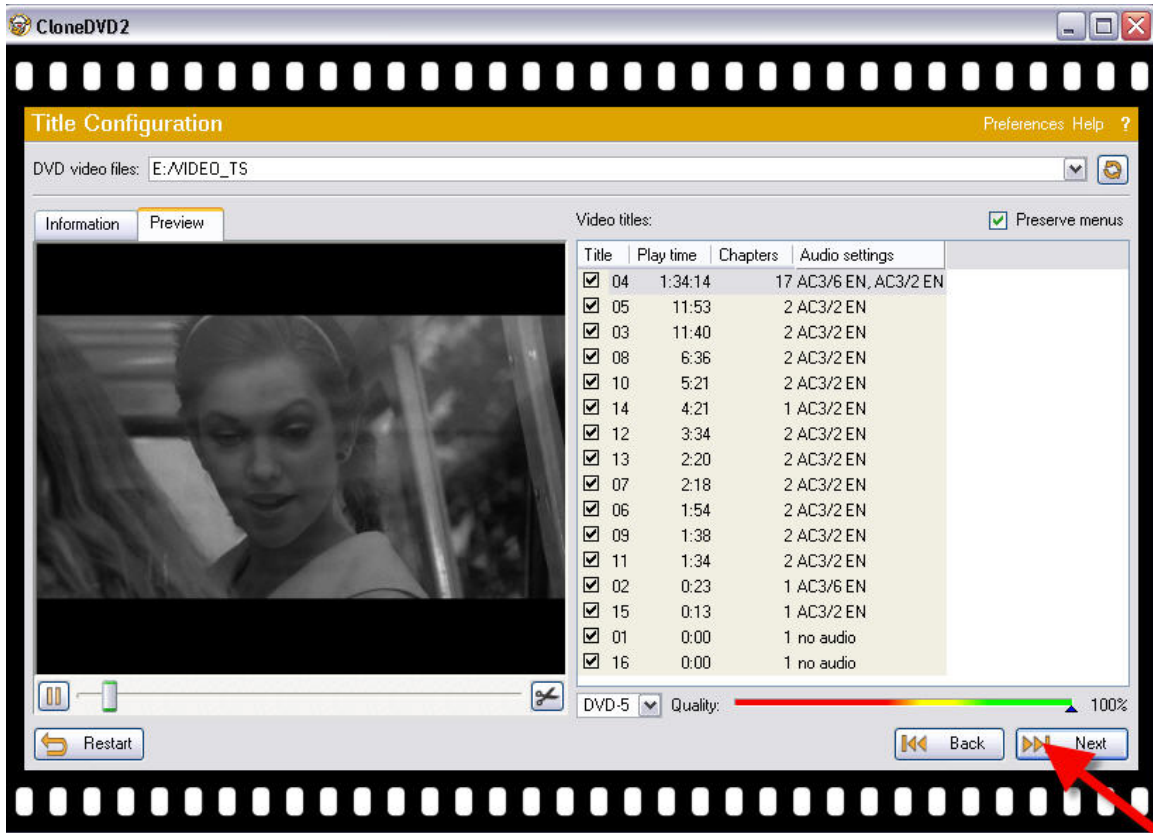
**Hit next.**



**This box is where you will chose the drive in which the disc to be copied resides.**

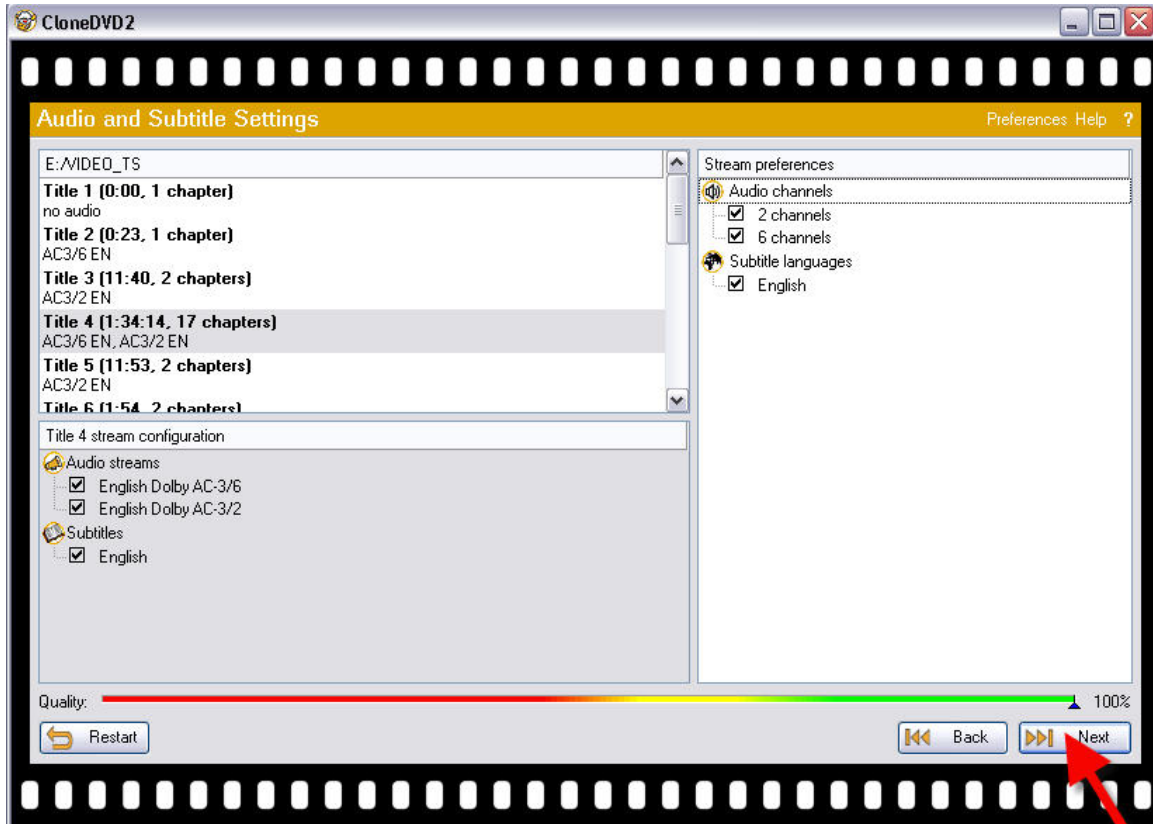
**A preview should start on the left hand side.**

**This box gives you the "Title Configuration". You do not need to change anything.**

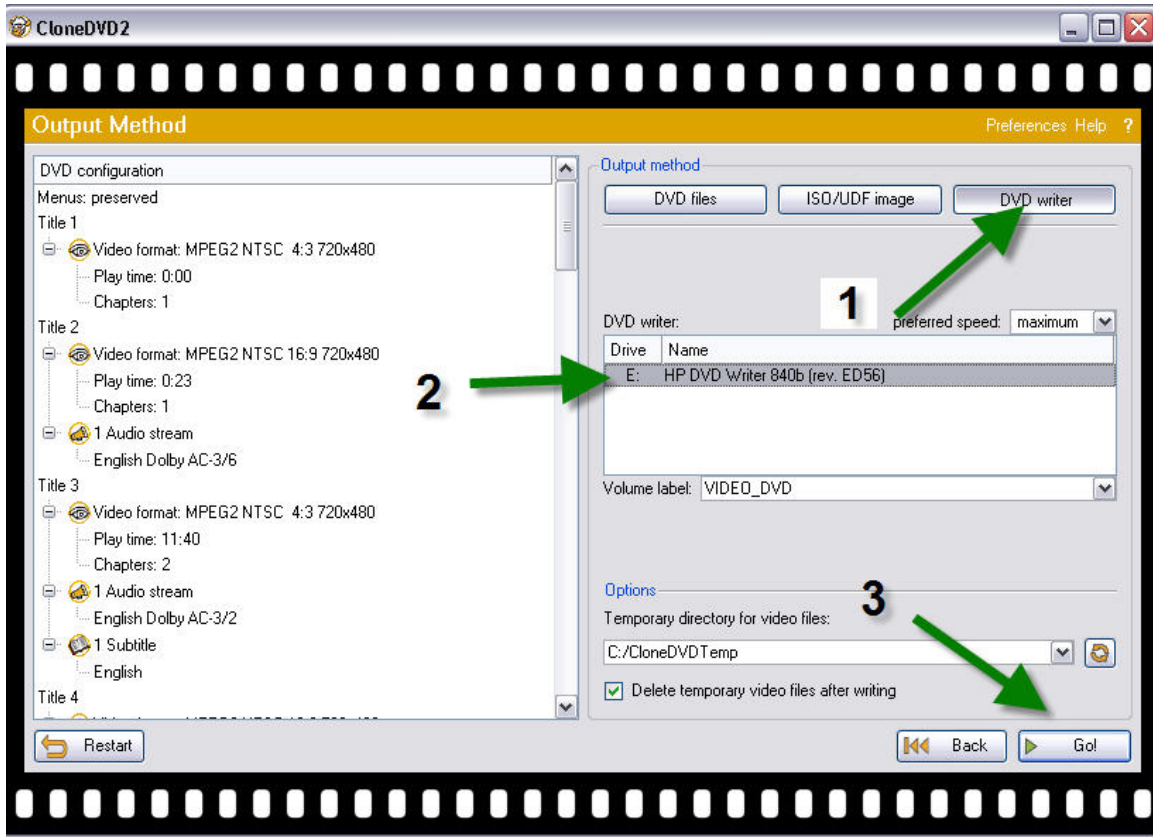
**Hit Next**

**Now select where the disc to be copied to resides.**

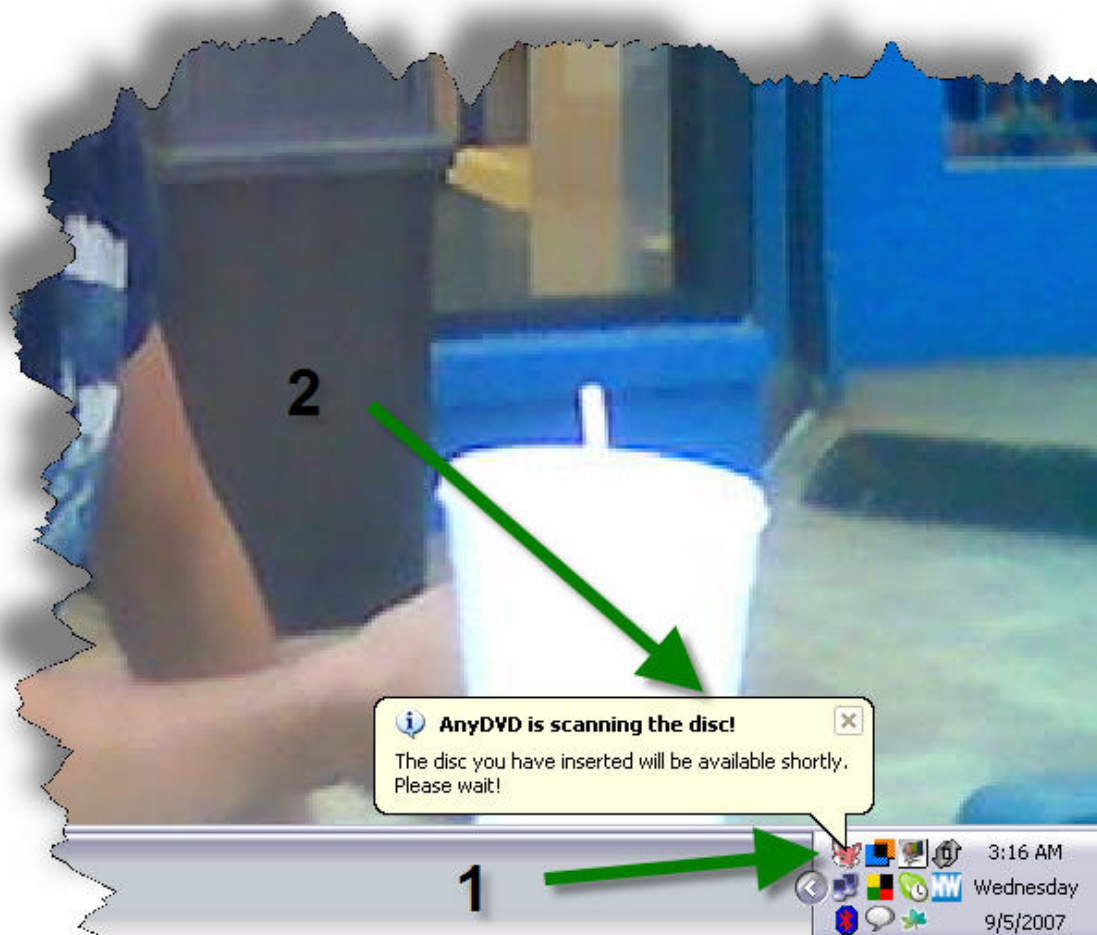
- 1. Select DVD writer.**
- 2. You should see the drive listed in this box.**
- 3. Hit go to make your copy.**
- 4. To make repeated copies just hit go again after the process completes.**



**To copy to your hard drive to burn later.**

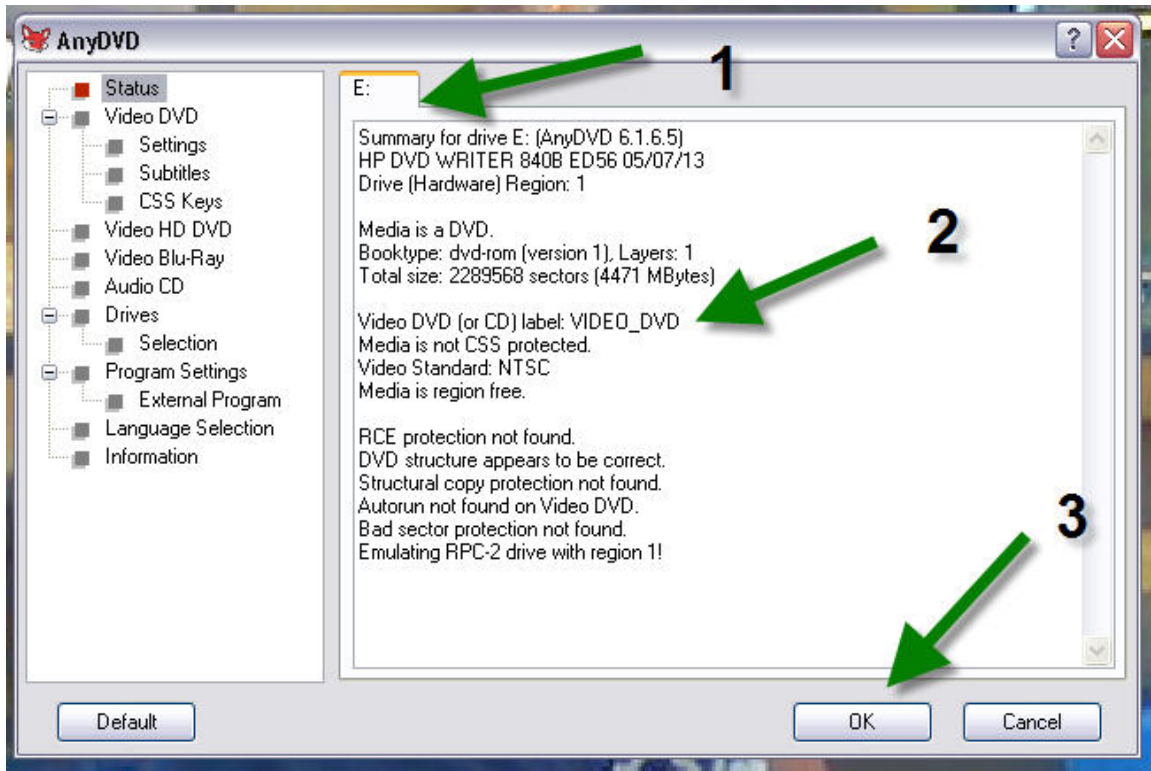
**First put the disc you want to copy in the Drive.**

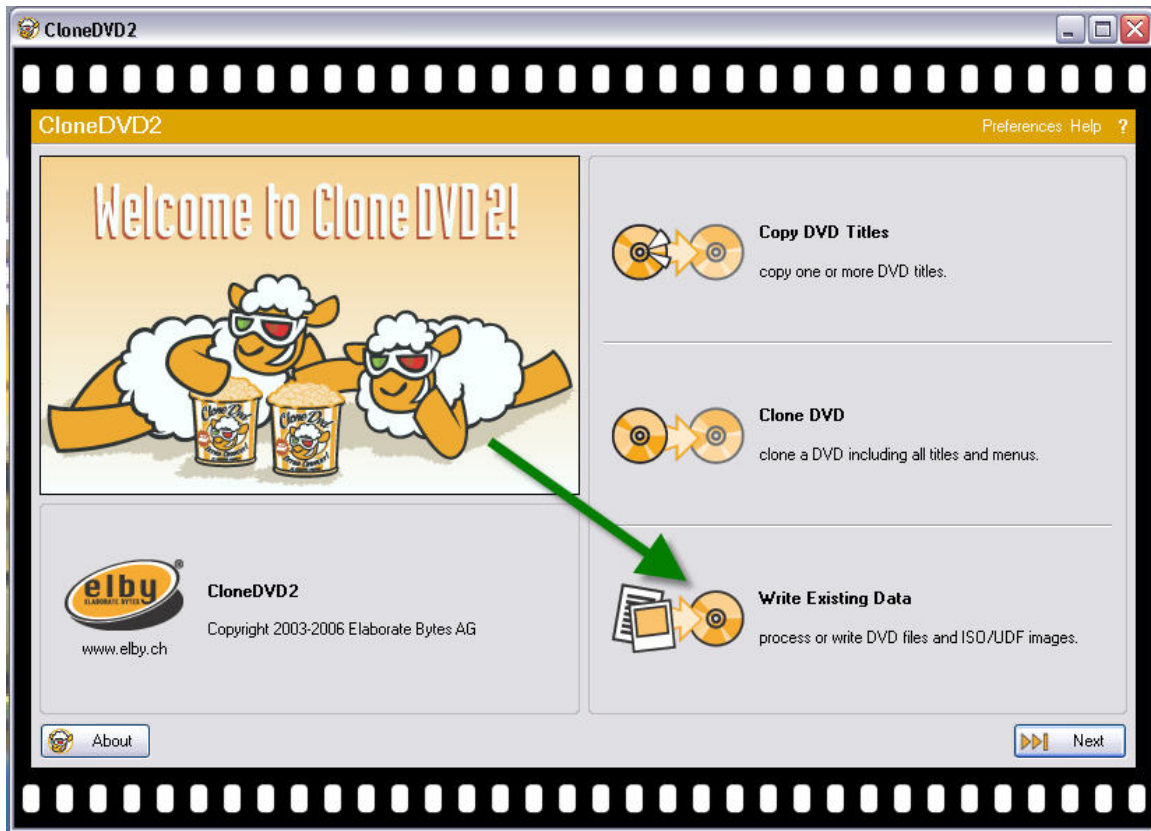
**Hit Next**



- 1. Chose "DVD Files"**
- 2. Select the folder you want to save the movie in. Make sure you put the name of the movie here or you will keep overwriting the existing movie. I recommend using the directory shown here.  
**C:/DVD Copies/"Your Movie Title"****
- 3. Hit go.**

**When the process is done you will have a copy of this movie on your hard drive.**

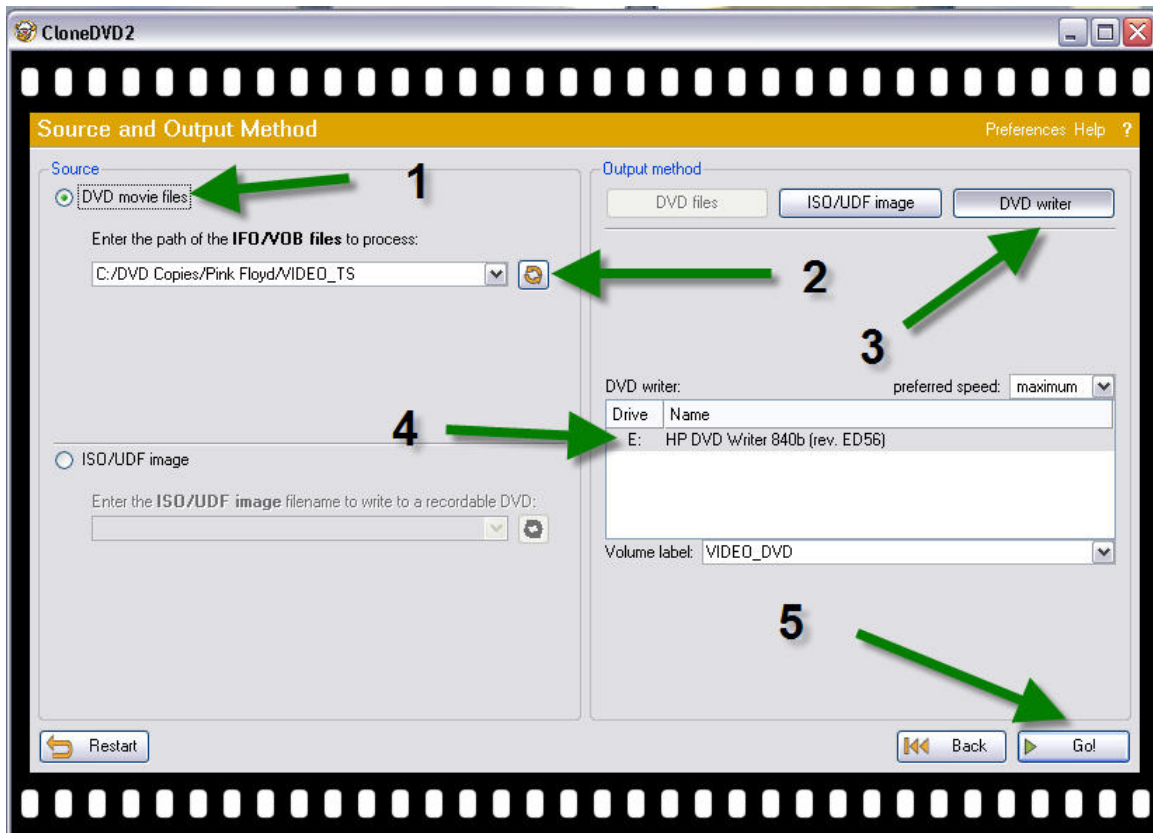
**To burn this copy to a disc open  
CloneDVD**



**Select "Write Existing Data"**

**Hit Next**

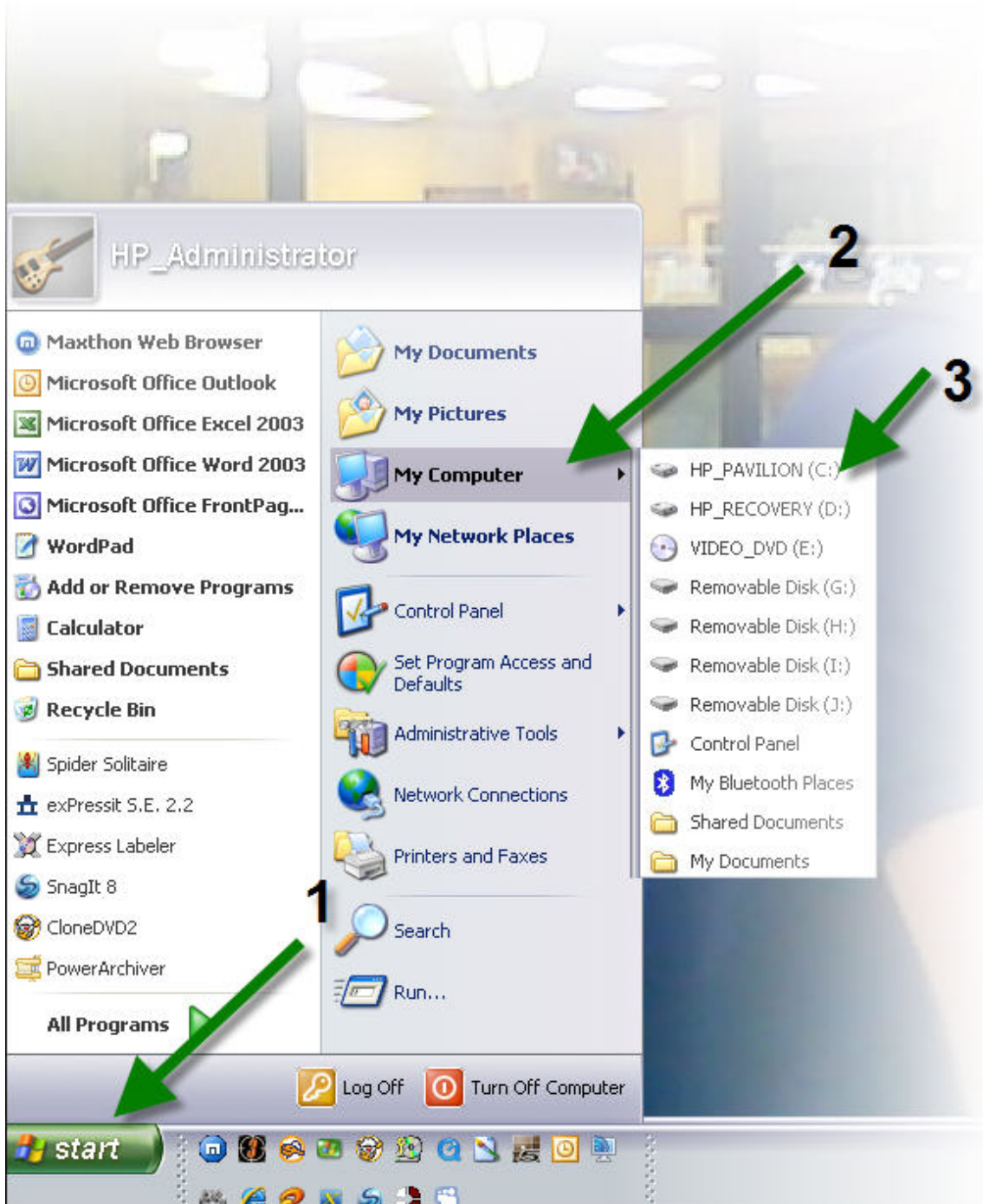




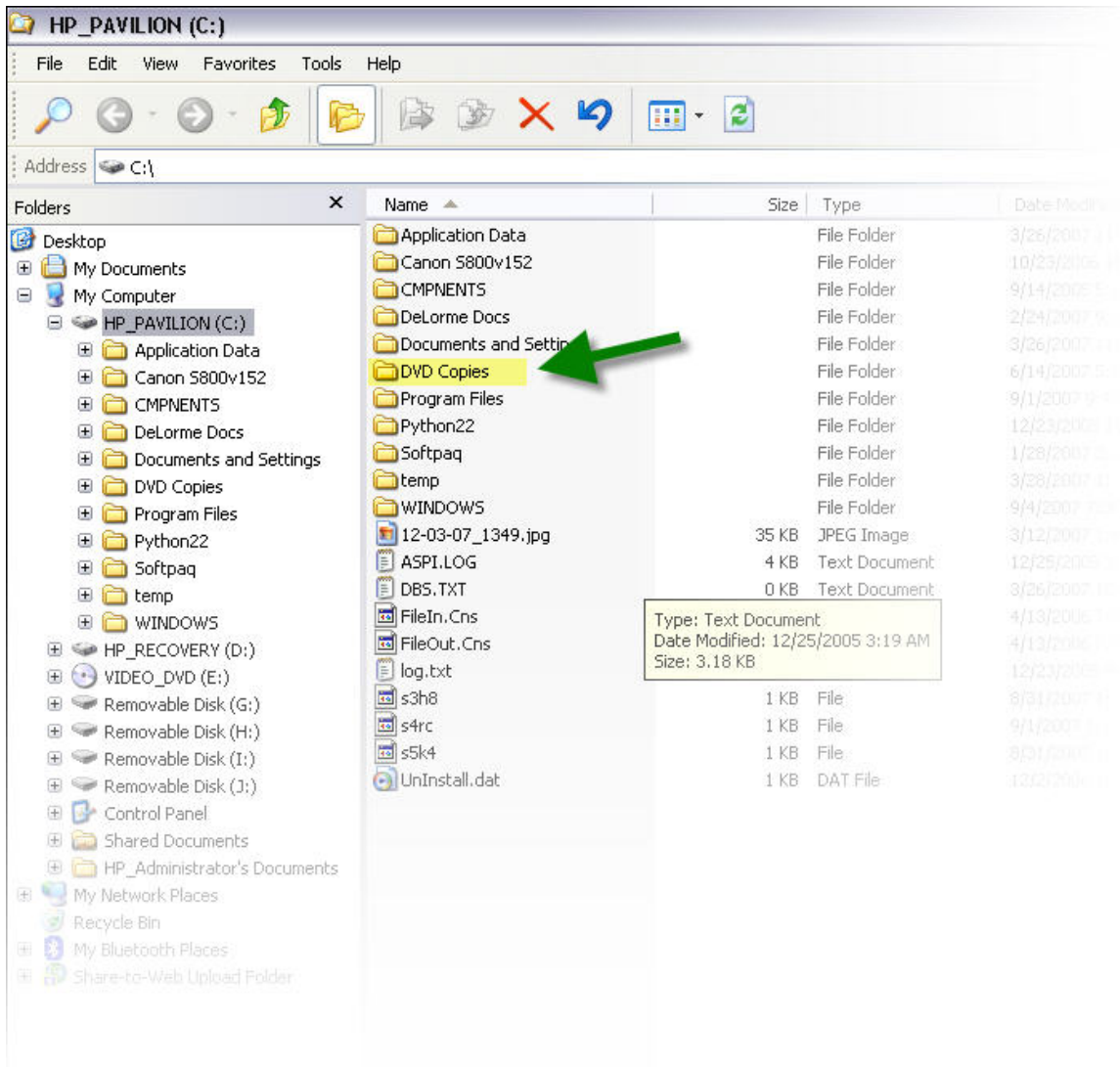
- 1. Select the Source**
- 2. The last movie you copied will already be in this window.**
- 3. Select "DVD Writer".**
- 4. Your writer should be listed in this box.**
- 5. Hit go.**

**Once this process completes you can make more of the same movie by hitting go again.**

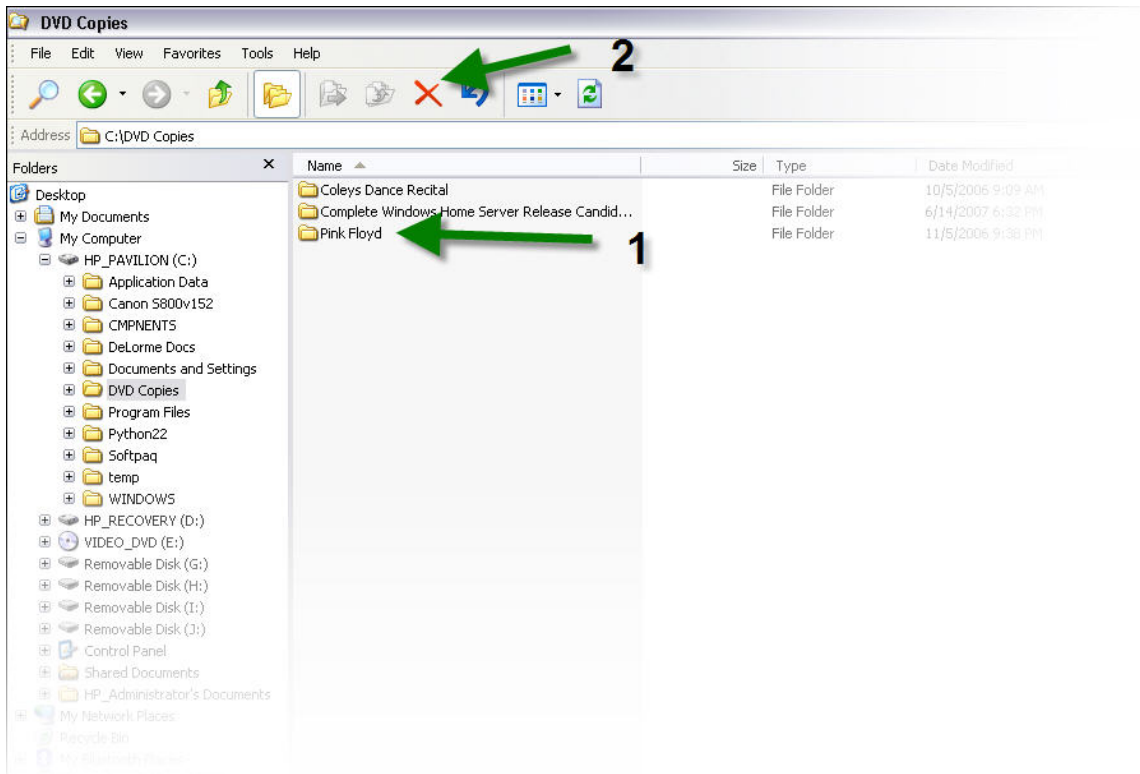
# To delete copied movies from your hard drive.



- 1. Click on your "start" button.**
- 2. Go to "MY Computer"**
- 3. Select your C:/ Drive**



**Open the "DVD Copies" Folder**



- 1. Select the title you want to delete.**
- 2. Hit the "Delete" button.**

**Don't forget to empty your "Recycle Bin" often.**
