## Waterwise



Our major project in the next two terms is to complete the Waterwise Special Interest Badge.

As a special interest badge, this qualifies as one of the requirements for the Grey Wolf Badge—an award all Cub Scouts should be working towards.

In the current climate of water restrictions and climate change it is important that we all do our bit to become aware of our own water usage.

The requirements for this badge will help us to appreciate Water as a resource, not just something that comes out of a tap. We will explore what Water is, where it comes from and the ways in which we can use less at home.

One of the tasks for this award, and one that will require your assistance, is to monitor water usage in the home. If you have a water meter then your cub will be recording the meter reading at the same time every week, for example on Sunday morning. After the second week, work out how much water is used in that week and discuss ways in which it could be reduced.

Make a note of some of the things you could do to try and reduce water usage and try to do some of them.

Take a reading on the third week and work out how much water was saved used when you were trying to save water.

## New Members

One of the challenges we face in Scouting is in attracting new members. Within the Moggill Group we have two very healthy Cub Packs and these are approaching the maximum size for the number of leaders we have.
