CUT TO:

14 INT. CIRCUS / MESS TENT - NIGHT

The circus crew and performers sit at a few tables. This is not a big circus. The clowns, led by BONKERS, sit at their own table: a morose and bitter lot.

At another table, acrobats and wire acts. There's also a strongman named MAGNUM and a psychic named MADAME NATASHA who sit with Henry Simon and Dorrie Lavalle.

Booth and Brennan enter with their trays of food -

BOOTH

Oh my God. It's high school. I wanna sit with the cool kids.

BRENNAN

(off clowns)

That group seems to be the most exclusive and insular.

BOOTH

Those are the clowns.

CONTINUED)

He heads toward Henry Simon and Dorrie Lavalle's table -

BRENNAN

How do you know?

BOOTH

I know.

BRENNAN

The psychiatric term for fear of clowns is coulrophobia.

BOOTH

What's the term for hating clowns? (off seats)

You mind?

HENRY SIMON

Buck, Wanda, meet Magnum the Strongman and Madame Natasha.

BRENNAN

Are those your real names?

MADAME NATASHA

Is "Wanda" your real name?

BRENNAN

As far as the world is concerned.

DORRIE LAVALLE

(to Magnum)

Buck and Wanda knew Jenny and Julie.

MAGNUM

I miss those girls.

He is emotional. Dorrie and Madame Natasha pat his back -

HENRY SIMON

Everybody misses them.

MAGNUM

Not the clowns.

BOOTH

I <u>hate</u> clowns.

DORRIE LAVALLE

Everyone hates clowns.

MADAME NATASHA

Except other clowns.

BRENNAN

Why don't the clowns miss the _twins?

MADAME NATASHA

The girls were trying a new act. They borrowed some of the clowns' equipment without asking.

HENRY SIMON

The girls should've stuck to juggling.

MAGNUM

They wanted more time in front of the audience.

MADAME NATASHA

Not Julie. She wanted less time so she could be with her gilly boyfriend.

Booth and Brennan look at each other -

BOOTH

Julie had a gilly boyfriend?

BRENNAN

A gilly is an outsider.

MAGNUM

She was pretty, Julie. And nice.

BRENNAN

But her sister was literally right beside her all the time.

HENRY SIMON

Fall in love with a gilly, that's the end of the circus life.

MAGNUM

People can't help who they fall in love with.

BOOTH

Who was he?

HENRY SIMON

A gilly.

CUT TO:

BOOTH

(to Brennan)

Don't you ever do that again, you hear me? Never!

BRENNAN

Why? They loved us. You were great. Superb hand eye coordination, Buckie.

BOOTH

I could have killed you.

BRENNAN

Therein lies the excitement for the spectators.

Booth turns away.

BOOTH

I don't believe you.

He is now facing the flap again and sees Magnum working with the acrobats. One acrobat is on a teeter board, Magnum stands at the other end, flexes his muscles for the crowd, then picks up his huge mallets and slams it down on his end of the teeter board, sending the acrobat skyward landing him on the shoulders of his partner across the ring.

BOOTH (CONT'D)

Oh my God!

BRENNAN

What?

BOOTH

Look at Magnum.

They both look as another acrobat is then launched by Magnum, landing on top of the other two acrobats.

BRENNAN


Yes. He definitely has the upper body strength to swing the foam barbell hard enough to cause the fractures.

CUT TO:

EXT. CIRCUS / BACK OF BIG TOP TENT - NIGHT

The show is over. The performers are heading back to their trailers. Booth and Brennan walk up to Magnum.

BOOTH

Hey, big guy, you got a minute?

MAGNUM

For what?

BOOTH

Just wanted to ask you about my friends Jenny and Julie.

MAGNUM

This is getting old. They were here and they left. That's all I know. Check with some other circuses maybe.

BRENNAN

They're dead. You knew that, didn't you?

This stops Magnum.

MAGNUM

Dead? What are you talking about?

BOOTH

Their heads were smashed together, weren't they, Magnum?

END

Magnum tries to take off, Booth puts out a hand to stop him. Magnum tosses him aside without effort. Brennan leaps on Magnum's back, putting a hand over his eyes and slugging him in the head. He whirls around, grabbing Brennan off his back and heaving her through the air. As she lands, Booth goes after Magnum again, drawing one of his knives. Magnum takes it away and slugs Booth who goes down again. Magnum grabs one of the large circus trunks and throws it at Booth who gets out of the way just in time. Magnum takes off as Booth and Brennan recover. They look to see where Magnum has gone, but he has disappeared into the night...

BRENNAN

Strong strongman.

Off Booth -

FADE OUT:

END OF ACT FIVE

BRENNAN

Yeah, yeah, I'm fine.

But the loses her balance, tosses her pole and falls into the net. Booth runs to her as she climbs down from the net.

BRENNAN (CONT'D)

[know what happened.

BOOTH

It's pretty obvious. You lost your balance.

BRENNAN

To the twins. They weren't murdered. The stress fractures to their fibules and cuboids... they were caused by walking on the wire. And the kissing fractures... their heads knocked together when they fell into the net. That's why there was no other trauma.

BOOTH

A conjoined twin high vire act?

BRENNAN

Henry said Jenny wanted to be famous. Their act would have been completely unique.

Start

CUT TO:

34 EXT. CIRCUS / AMONGST THE TRAILERS - NIGHT

34

Booth and Brennan exit and move toward their trailer -

BOOTH

That's a first; cover up an accident by making it look like a murder.

MAGNUM (O.S.)

I didn't kill them.

They see Magnum standing before them, dejected -

BRENNAN

We know.

MAGNUM

I buried them.

BOOTH

You should've picked softer ground and dug deeper, pal.

Out of the darkness, the other circus people approach, listening -

DORRIE LAVALLE

Don't say anything, Magnum.

BRENNAN

You asked them not to go on the high wire but that's what they wanted to do.

Probably the only-thing Julie and Jenny-ever-agreed on.

BRENNAN

When they dropped into the net the force of the fall snapped their heads together.

BOOTH

An-accident like that, you knew their mother would sue. You knew the circus wouldn't survive.

Tt's true

BRENNAN

We have to arrest you.

BOOTH

Interference with a dead body.

BRENNAN

We're... sorry. (to Booth)

BOOTH

Yeah, Bones We're sorry.

BRENNAN

(to Magnum)

We're gonna get you a good lawyer.

Henry Simon looks at the others, then at Dorrie -

MAGNUM

That'll be the end of it?

And you'll have to explain how you forged their handwriting on the note.

Dorrie and Madame Natasha nod. All the circus people come over to touch Magnum. Even the clowns.

Brennan and Booth stand back and watch. They are not part of this.

BOOTH

In a few minutes, I'll call the Dallas field office, have him taken in.

BRÉNNAN

What about us?

BOOTH

We go back to our real lives.

They watch the circus people surround Magnum, pat him on the back, shake his hand.

CUT TO:

EXT. EMPTY CIRCUS GROUNDS - DAY

Early in the morning.

Everything is gone except for "Buck and Wanda's" mobile home. The door opens, and Booth exits, sleep rumpled.

He registers for a moment that the field is empty. A little bit of litter. A handbill blows against his leg. He bends over to pick it up.
