Biography

Final Notice is the creation of Tony Serrano: lead guitarist and vocalist. Tony was born in Puerto Rico, and then moved to Brooklyn, NY at age 3. He later moved to New Jersey and raised 2 sons. While in Jersey, he met up with a drummer, singer, and another guitarist. This was the first incarnation of Final Notice.

Years later, Tony and his son, Anthony Serrano, moved to Virginia. They reformed Final Notice and began playing at some local clubs. That went on for about 2 years. Then, Anthony joined a band called Westminster Core (W.C.). That band recorded a two-song CD. The drummer for W.C. was named Chris Sherman.

Tony joined up with W.C., but the band had a falling out. The 3 remaining members: Tony, Chris, & Anthony, started a 3-piece called New York Connection. All three members had relocated to Virginia from the NYC area.

In March of 2001, out of the blue, Sherman got a call from a guitarist he used to jam with named Eric Stephens. Their former band "Runt" enjoyed success playing a set of all original tunes.

Eric expressed interest in joining a band, so an audition was set up. After one rehearsal, Eric was added to the line-up. New York Connection took the old name Final Notice. The band recorded a six-song demo in Sept. 2001, then returned to the studio in Jan. 2003 to record six more original tracks. Their live set contains mostly cover tunes—Classic Rock, Hard Rock, Alternative, Blues, and anything in between.

Final Notice has been playing clubs and private parties for four years. They were featured in a Television spot for Bubba's Beach Club (Channels LNC5 & WB43). They are currently gigging and continuing to build a following in the Norfolk/Virginia Beach area.
