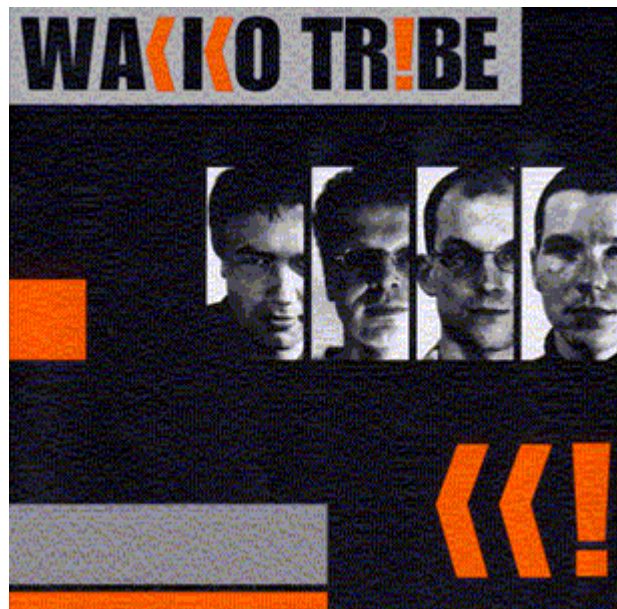
We want to play. And now you can book us!
