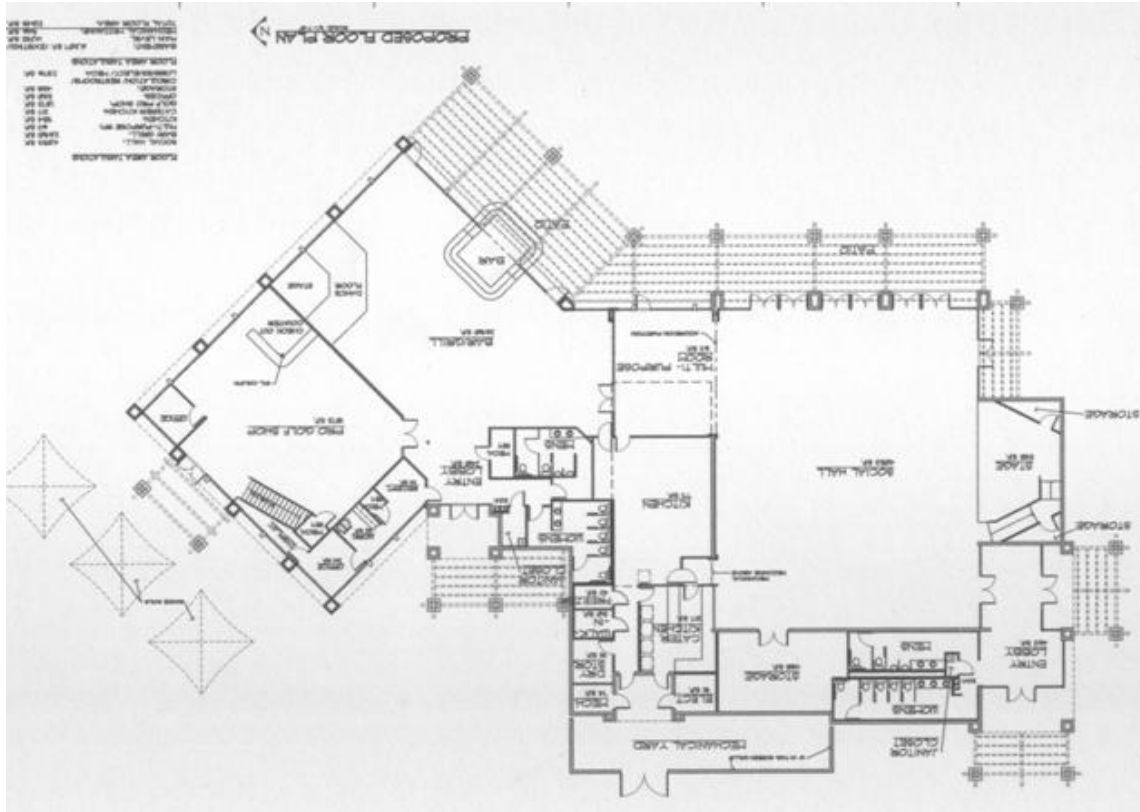
*There was also a vote to increase the size of the Social Hall, that proposal did not pass. The AWCC is open to an enlargement of the Social Hall if funds become available.*
