## New Clubhouse Planned


On January 11,2008 the Apache Wells Country Club (AWCC) voted to proceed with the construction of a new building. The vote for the new building passed by a vote of 216 in favor, 140 against.

There was also a vote to increase the size of the Social Hall, that proposal did not pass. The AWCC is open to an enlargement of the Social Hall if funds become available. The assessment, for Country Club members only, is \$6200 payable beginning April 1, 2008.
