

However, we have chosen to engage the Maricopa County Election Committee to conduct our January 6, 2009 Board of Directors Election. This decision was arrived at in the attempt to bring in an independent disinterested organization to eliminate any post election debates as to violations of conduct regarding our residents that served on the Election Committee. In the past year I've heard post election remarks ranging from ballot tampering by our office staff to numerous violations by our Election Committee.
