SRP is concerned about customer safety. That's why we want to alert you to a nationwide phone scam regarding bill payment. Scam artists falsely claiming to be utility employees are calling customers threatening to disconnect power unless the victims "pay the bill" by providing a credit card number. In some cases, the caller instructs the customer to purchase a prepaid debit card from a local store.

Protect yourself

SRP does not call customers and ask for banking information.

Never give personal information to callers or visitors without knowing their true identity.
