At the last Board of Directors meeting the Board reconfirmed a decision of a few weeks ago that we will be demolishing and replacing the Fitness Center. We shall pledge the Associations Accounts Receivable/Assessments to Choice Financial Group as partial collateral for a \$400,000 five-year loan. The balance of collateral required will be a \$125,000 five-year CD held by Choice Financial Group in our name with interest payable to us.
