

SWIMMING POOL RULES

MEMBERS: Members must have pool card and sign registration sheet. Include lot #.

GUESTS: Only guests of Property Owners and Renters may be guests. Property Owners/Renters may purchase \$5.00 guest badges at the Homeowner Office, refundal when returned. Badges have no expiration date. Guests not accompanied by a member must have the member's pool card and a guest badge. They must sign the registration sheet as a guest, and include the member's lot number.

HOURS: The pool is open from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily.

HOURS FOR CHILDREN OVER AGE 3 and UNDER AGE 18:

No children may be in the pool from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., or from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily, except during three holidays when they may use the pool any time it is open. Those holidays are:

Thanksgiving --- Wednesday through Sunday

Christmas ----- Saturday before Christmas through New Year's Day

Easter ----- Thursday through Monday

Children under 18 years of age must always be accompanied by a member or authorized adult guest. Children under 3 years of age are never permitted in the pool.

SHOWERS: Swimmers must shower before entering pool or spa.

AGE LIMIT IN SPA: Persons under age 18 are never permitted in the spa.

LAP-SWIMMING LANES: Two lap lanes are defined by tile on the pool bottom. Swimmers should avoid blocking these lanes when lap swimmers are present.

PROHIBITED:

- Persons wearing diapers.
- Children under 3 years of age.
- Pets.
- Radios without headphones, (except those used by organized swim classes).
- Glass containers, food, or alcoholic beverages.
- Roller blades or skates on pool deck.
- Persons having open cuts, sores, or rashes.
- Inner tubes, rafts, or inflatable boats. (Noodles, rubber belts, arm floats, etc. that enhance safety or exercise are allowed).

HOSTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR GUESTS.

THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. SWIMMING ALONE IS DANGEROUS.
