MARRIAGE ACT OF ONTARIO


(2) Every person who solemnizes a marriage shall, at the time of the marriage, if required by either of the parties thereto, give a certificate of the marriage specifying the names of the parties, the date of the marriage, the names of the witnesses, and whether the marriage was solemnized under the authority of a licence or publication of banns. R.S.O. 1990, c. M.3, s. 28 (2).

29. (1) Every person or religious body authorized to solemnize marriages may apply to the Minister for a marriage register, and the Minister shall thereupon supply the register. R.S.O. 1990, c. M.3, s. 29 (1).

Property of Crown

(2) Every register supplied by the Minister is the property of the Crown. R.S.O. 1990, c. M.3, s. 29 (2).

Protection of persons solemnizing marriage in good faith

30. No person who solemnizes or purports to solemnize a marriage is subject to any action or liability by reason of there having been any legal impediment to the marriage unless, at the time the person performed the ceremony, he or she was aware of the impediment. R.S.O. 1990, c. M.3, s. 30.

Marriages solemnized in good faith

31. If the parties to a marriage solemnized in good faith and intended to be in compliance with this Act are not under a legal disqualification to contract such marriage and after such solemnization have lived together and cohabited as man and wife, such marriage shall be deemed a valid marriage, although the person who solemnized the marriage was not authorized to solemnize marriage, and despite the absence of or any irregularity or insufficiency in the publication of banns or the issue of the licence. R.S.O. 1990, c.M.3, s. 31.
