

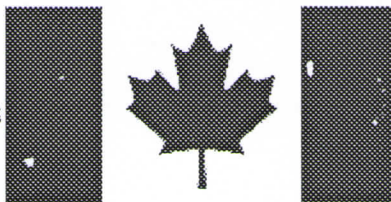

## Ordination by Mail Ministry VS United States of America



---

In 1974 a ministry which ordained people in a simple manner by mail, and by other means, sued the United States Government. The suit was over taxes. However, when the Federal Judge ruled in the ministry's favor on taxes he also ruled on the legality of receiving ordination in a simple manner.

---

Here is part of the Federal Judge's decision concerning simple ordination.

"The Court must then address itself to the defendant's second conclusion: that the ordination of ministers, the granting of church charters, and the issuance of Honorary Doctor of Divinity certificates by plaintiff are substantial activities which do not further any religious purpose. Certainly *the ordination of ministers and the chartering of churches are accepted activities of religious organizations*. The defendant impliedly admits that same on Page 5 of its Memorandum in Support of its Requested Instructions. The fact that the plaintiff distributed ministers credentials and Honorary Doctor of Divinity certificates is of no moment. Such activity may be analogized to mass conversions at a typical revival or religious crusade. Neither this Court, nor any branch of this Government, will consider the merits or fallacies of a religion. Nor will the Court compare the beliefs, dogmas, and practices of a newly organized religion with those of an older, more established religion. Nor will the Court praise or condemn a religion, however excellent or fanatical or preposterous it may seem. Were the Court to do so, it would impinge upon the guarantees of the First Amendment."

COMMENT: As a result of this Federal Judge's ruling, ministries started by mail ordained clergy have been flourishing throughout the United States, and in many other countries throughout the world.

By this Agreement the signatories' acknowledge that the Universal Life Church, International Headquarters, is not responsible for any debts incurred by the local Universal Life Church.

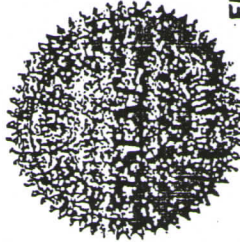

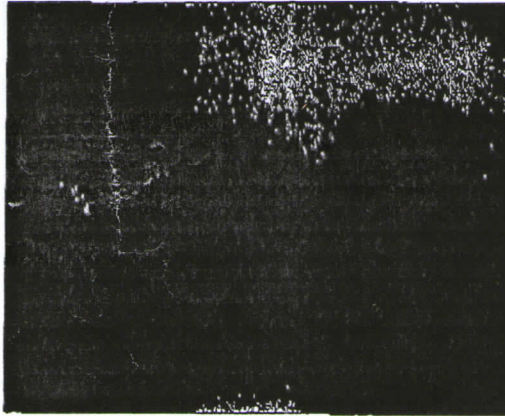

In 1996, the Government of Ontario granted the HAC permission to perform legally recognized marriages. Plans are being made to offer Humanist weddings and funeral ceremonies throughout Canada. The first funeral service conducted by an HAC celebrant was held in March 1995, the first HAC wedding ceremony was held in August 1996, and in June 1998, HAC performed its first naming and indoctrination ceremony.

**BRIEF HISTORY OF WORLD HUMANISM** .....

Humanism began in ancient Greece, when some philosophers rejected the traditional concepts about the gods and proclaimed that morality was based on human principles. Eventually, various political and religious authorities slowly buried this humanist trend because it challenged their control. For centuries, it was dangerous to admit to being an "atheist".

**THE ENLIGHTENMENT** .....

Humanism re-emerged in the 18th century. Humanists were referred to as Naturalists, Rationalists, Deists, Freethinkers. Christians called them skeptics or infidels. By the time Charles Darwin wrote his *On the Origin of Species* (1859), science was challenging conventional thought on all sides. Scientific questioning of accepted dogma opened many minds to the Humanist viewpoint.

**HUMANISM WORLD WIDE TODAY** .....

In 1952, the first International Congress of the *International Humanist and Ethical Union* (IHEU) was held in Amsterdam. IHEU represents more than 3 million members in 30 countries, has consultative status at the United Nations and is now headquartered in London, England. The 21st of June is known as International Humanist Day.
