

NARRATIVE SPEECH

~ 50 POINTS ~

- For this assignment, you need to watch the Movie *Clue*
- Take copious notes as though you were a detective on a fact finding mission
- Pay close attention to people, rooms, weapons, relationships and anything else that might help you figure out who is committing the murders
- You will be writing a story to turn in to a speech.
 - You will be assigned a character from the movie
 - You will be telling your story from the point of view of that particular character
 - You are telling this as though you are on trial for the murders... you must include very specific details... for example you want to make it feel like we are there in the story with you. Tell us about smells, colors, textures, clothes, sounds, etc.
 - You may choose any of the endings that you deem necessary to either confess to the crimes, or to try to get away with murder, or you are truly innocent
- You will need to use descriptive language, be concise on the details of the evening, and deliver this in a tone that is sincere and appears truthful
- There is no set-in-stone format for this speech. The following requirements must be in your speech:
 - 5 minutes
 - specific details from the movie
 - Your intro or conclusion should proclaim your innocence or guilt
 - You need to introduce your character and speak as though you are that character (I am not looking for accents, but if you are Miss. Scarlet, I expect you to say, "I loved my silky green dress." Instead of saying, "Miss. Scarlet wore a silky green dress to the party.")
