- 1. Write an essay in which you explore **one** of the following 3 choices... you must utilize specific details from the 3 aforementioned movies:

Hint: Look into the time era (women's rights movement), and see how things have changed from Mad World, to The Great Race, to Rat Race. You should incorporate historical/social movements.

- b. Why are races and/or chases so alluring to be in, and to watch?
- c. Why do people who are normally decent go crazy, lie, cheat, steal, play dirty, etc. in the name of winning money or for competition?
- 2. Do <u>not</u> simply summarize what happened in the films... I have seen them and know this already. You need to go beyond regurgitation and find meaning under the surface. You MUST find and use SPECIFIC details from the movies to support your ideas/arguments/claims.

Those without computers at home:
